

NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31st MARCH 2014

1. Accounting Policies

Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Sales

Sales represents the value of goods sold by the company in the U.K., net of VAT.

Intangible fixed assets and amortisation

Goodwill is the difference between the amount paid on the acquisition of the business and the fair value of the net assets. It is amortised to profit and loss account over its estimated economic life of five years.

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual value, of each asset over its expected useful life on the following basis:

Fixtures and fittings	20% per annum reducing balance basis
Motor vehicles	20% per annum reducing balance basis

Leasing

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged to the profit and loss account as incurred.

Hire purchase contracts and finance leases

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts and finance leases are capitalised as tangible fixed assets and depreciated over their expected useful lives on the same basis as shown above. Obligations under such agreements are included in creditors net of the finance charge allocated to future periods. The finance element of the rental obligations is charged to the Profit and Loss Account on a straight line basis over the period of the agreement.

Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

Deferred taxation

The charge for taxation takes into account taxation deferred as a result of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. Provision is made using the liability method in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed by the balance sheet date.

However, deferred tax assets are recognised only where it is considered more likely than not that future profits will be available for offset.

The company has not adopted a policy of discounting deferred tax assets and liabilities.
