Please find attached a draft of my final report on the progress of the Liquidation

By way of reminder, I was appointed Liquidator of the Company at a meeting of creditors held on 21 October 2010 at The Norfolk Club, 17 Upper King Street, Norwich NR3 1RB I am authorised to act as an Insolvency Practitioner by the Insolvency Practitioners Association

I am required to send to creditors, a draft of the report which I intend laying before the final meeting of the Company's creditors at least 8 weeks before the meeting is held. This report provides details of the outcome of the liquidation and is also being circulated to the members at the same time for administrative purposes

I now propose convening the final meetings of the Company's members and creditors pursuant to Section 106 of the Insolvency Act 1986 and give notice that these meetings will be held at Trafalgar House, Grenville Place, London NW7 3SA on 17 August 2011 at 2 00pm and 2 05pm respectively for the purpose of receiving a final account of the my acts and dealings and of the conduct of the winding up

A member or creditor entitled to attend and vote at the meetings may appoint a proxy to attend and vote in his place. It is not necessary for the proxy to be a member or creditor. A form of proxy is attached. Proxy forms must be returned to the offices of B&C Associates Limited, Trafalgar House, Grenville Place, Mill Hill, London NW7 3SA by not later than 12 00 noon on 16 August 2011.

At these meetings the report will be presented and I will seek approval of the following resolutions

- That the Liquidator's Receipts and Payments account to 15 June 2011 and final report be approved,
- That the Liquidator be released from office,
- That the Company's books and records be destroyed twelve months after the date of dissolution

1 Introduction

- This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation. At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the period ended 17 August 2011 with a comparison to the Directors' Statement of Affairs values ("SoA"), together with a cumulative account since the date of my appointment
- The Liquidation commenced on 21 October 2010 with estimated asset values of £116 and anticipated liabilities of £419,721, which subject to the costs of the Liquidation expected no return to creditors

2 Realisation of Assets

2 1 Cash at Bank

A total of £115 78 was realised from the Company's former banking facility, held at HSBC Bank plc

3 Expenses of the Liquidation

3 1 Liquidator's Disbursements

Disbursements have been incurred in accordance with SIP9, at the rate detailed on the attached schedule, totalling £96 48 This sum relates entirely to Statutory Advertising costs

4 Investigations

In accordance with the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 I have submitted a report on the conduct of the Directors of the Company to the Department for BIS As this is a confidential report, I am not able to disclose the contents

5 Creditors

5 1 Preferential Creditors

No preferential claims were received in this matter and none were expected

5 2 Unsecured Creditors

I have received and agreed claims totalling £384,801 10 from 11 creditors. However, as there have been insufficient realisations in the Liquidation, no prospect of a dividend was likely and there no steps were taken to fully adjudicate these claims.

6 Liquidator's Remuneration

- The Creditors approved that the basis of the Liquidator's remuneration be fixed by reference to the time properly spent by him and his staff in managing the Liquidation
- My time costs for the period from 21 October 2010 to 17 August 2011 are £4,830 This represents 28 hours at an average rate of £172 50 per hour Attached as Appendix B is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during this period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent by me in managing the Liquidation A total of £19 30 has been drawn against this sum
- As detailed by Appendix B, the majority of my time incurred in the Liquidation was used in dealing with statutory matters, such as filing necessary paperwork with Companies House and conducting initial investigations into the Company's affairs
- Attached as Appendix C is additional information in relation to our policy on staffing, the use of subcontractors, disbursements and details of our current charge-out rates by staff grade

7 Creditors' rights

- Within 21 days of the receipt of this report, a secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors) may request in writing that the Liquidator provide further information about his remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in this progress report
- Any secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors) may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report make an application to court on the grounds that the basis fixed for the Liquidator's remuneration, the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred by the Liquidator as set out in this progress report are excessive

8 Conclusion

This report together with final meetings of members and creditors will conclude my administration. Details of the final meetings and resolutions to be considered have been circulated with this report.

1 Policy

1 1 Staff allocation and the use of subcontractors

Our general approach to resourcing our assignments is to allocate staff with the skills and experience to meet the specific requirements of the case

The constitution of the case team will usually consist of a Director, Manager, Senior and Assistant The exact constitution of the case team will depend on the anticipated size and complexity of the assignment and on larger, more complex cases, several Seniors/Assistants may be allocated to meet the demands of the case

With regard to support staff, we would advise that time spent by cashiers in relation to specific tasks on an assignment is charged

We have not utilised the services of any subcontractors in this case

1 2 Disbursements

Category 1 disbursements do not require approval by creditors. The type of disbursements that may be charged as a Category 1 disbursement to a case generally comprise of external supplies of incidental services specifically identifiable to the case, such as postage, case advertising, invoiced travel and external printing, room hire and document storage. Also chargeable will be any properly reimbursed expenses incurred by personnel in connection with the case.

1 3 Charge-out rates

A schedule of B&C Associates Limited charge-out rates was issued to creditors at the time the basis of the Liquidator's remuneration was approved. There has been no material increase in charge-out rates since that date and accordingly no up to date schedule is attached.
