- (C) unless the said proposed litigation is completed in the interim, at 6 monthly intervals from the date of the order serve on the Registrar of Companies a full and sufficient Witness Statement setting out what steps have been taken to progress the said proposed litigation

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and the Registrar of Companies (the Defendant) both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED that

- (1) the name of the above named Hospitality & Grow Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) the Company do continue in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation
- (3) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 06880202 Limited
- (4) an Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (5) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

- (6) in the event that the Claimant fails to comply with the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to take any action in respect of the Company without the Claimant
- (7) the claimant Fran Brooks do pay the Registrar his costs of the said application in the agreed
