**Principal activities** 

The principal activity of the company is to carry on activities, which benefit the Muslim community by providing

- 2 Free lectures dealing with issues related to the community, such as the importance of education, diversity and the dangers of extremism etc
- 3 Free distribution of educational materials
- 4 The promotion of better community cohesion and education

#### **Business Review**

Income in the year under review was £1,983. This was the fourth year for the An-Naseeha Foundation Community Interest Company and the service has been steady this year with a much lower income levels than previous year. We will hopefully be in a much better position with services increasing next year. The company finished with a strong cash position at year-end.
