### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Aid for All Ltd is registered as a charity with the Charity Commission and was established on 21 May 2009. The charity is constituted as a company limited by guarantee and is therefore governed by a Memorandum and Articles of Association. The charity is managed by trustees who are responsible for setting the strategic directions of the organisation and for establishing policy.

### RISK MANAGEMENT

The trustees have conducted a review of the major risks to which the charity is exposed. Where appropriate, systems or procedures have been established to mitigate the risks the charity faces. Internal control risks are minimised by the implementation of procedures for authorisation of all transactions and projects. Procedures are in place to ensure compliance with health and safety of staff, and volunteers, and visitors to the centres. These procedures are periodically reviewed to ensure that they continue to meet the needs of the charity. The charity manages its financial risk by setting a reserves policy which is regularly reviewed by trustees.

### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

The principal objectives of the charity throughout the year has been

- 1 Advancing education
- 2 Relieving poverty
- 3 Retraining individuals for reemployment

### THE AIM OF THE CHARITY IS

To advance education by providing grants and bursaries to schools and other educational institutions, in order to enhance learning and promote studing for the public's benefit.

To focus on the relief of poverty by providing beneficiaries with financial aid and other assistance allowing them to meet their basic living cost.

To help people discover their career opportunities and regain employment through training for specific qualifications.

### **PUBLIC BENEFIT**

The trustees have considered the guidance published by the Charity Commission and believe that the charity in carrying out its objectives, fully complies with these requirements. In particular the distribution of funds to other locally managed charities automatically gives rise to a public benefit. Each year the trustees review the objectives and activities of the charity to ensure that they continue to reflect these aims. In carrying out this review the trustees have considered the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit and in particular its supplementary public guidance on the advancement of religion for the public benefit.

### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The charity is organised so that the governors meet regularly to manage its affairs.

### FINANCIAL REVIEW

The statement of financial activities shows a net profit for the year amounting to £42,326 after making the substantial donations of £61,678. The reserves stand at £38,658 in total.

### PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

The governors intend to continue performing at similar levels to current year which has been most satisfactory. Substantial donations will continue to be paid to various institutions.

### YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2015

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 31 May 2015 which are set out on pages 6 to 9

### RESPECTIVE RESPONSIBILITIES OF TRUSTEES AND EXAMINER

The trustees (who are also the directors of Aid for All Limited for the purposes of company law) are responsible for the preparation of the accounts.
