

Under The Sun Creative Outdoor Learning (UTS) continued to promote outdoor learning, delivering a programme of workshops in North Yorkshire, bringing stories to life in an outdoor setting, incorporating drama, storytelling & making skills. Activities were aimed at children and family groups.

UTS again worked with a local woodland 'friends' group, providing creative workshops for local school children. The sessions were designed to encourage greater understanding of the woodland environment and promote the children's longterm custodianship of the wood UTS were commissioned by Yorkshire Sculpture Park to deliver public workshops looking at environment and habitat. A permanent 'Habitat' installation was created using reclaimed & natural materials.

UTS also undertook tree planting in a voluntary project with a local 'playgroup' Due to Sure Start funding cuts, UTS were unable to develop further projects
