Following my appointment as Joint Liquidator of the above Company on 13 May 2014 I am now in a position to submit my Final Report pursuant to Section 94 of the Insolvency Act 1986. This report should be read in conjunction with my previous reports, further copies of which will be supplied on request

I confirm that all asset realisations and administration of the liquidation have been completed and that no comments were received following the issue of the draft final report in this matter on 13 October 2016

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Liquidators' Receipts and Payments Account to 22 November 2016

Attached is a copy of the Liquidators' Receipts and Payments Account to 22 November 2016, showing that all funds have now been distributed

The principal items of income and expenditure incurred to date are discussed in more detail below

1 ASSET REALISATIONS

1.1 Director's Loan Account ("DLA")

At the date of Liquidation, £821,064 was owed to the Company in respect of your overdrawn loan account. This was repaid in full on 11 May 2016 out of your first capital distribution.

1 2 S455 Tax Refund

I can confirm that the previously reported £180,266 in respect of S455 tax refund, which had arisen from the DLA settlement has been received into the estate. Following receipt of this refund, HMRC have confirmed that they have no further points to raise, so we can now proceed with the closure of the Liquidation.

13 Cash at Bank

At the date of Liquidation, the Company's bank account was in credit at £78,421. The bank account was closed and the funds were received in full on 13 May 2015.

1.4 Corporation Tax Refund

As previously reported, an amount of £1,869 was due to the Company in respect of a Corporation Tax refund from the tax computation for the period to 13 May 2014. I can confirm that this has been received into the estate

1.5 VAT Refund

I can confirm that £552 has been received into the estate in respect of a VAT refund. We await a further refund of the VAT arising on final fees

1.6 Interest from Corporation Tax Refund

On receipt of the S455 tax refund, I can confirm an amount of £302 was received in interest, which was subject to a Corporation Tax charge from HM Revenue and Customs

1.7 Bank Interest

An amount of £202 was received into the estate in respect of bank interest

2 COSTS OF REALISATIONS

2.1 Liquidators' Fees and Disbursements

At the meeting of the shareholder held on 13 May 2014, it was resolved that the Liquidators' fees be calculated by reference to the reasonable time costs incurred in dealing with the Liquidation. It was initially estimated that the costs would be in the region of £7,500 plus VAT and disbursements, on the assumption that there would be no matters delaying the completion of the case.

However, due to a delay in obtaining signed returns and the subsequent delay in HMRC remitting the S455 tax refund, the Liquidators were not able to complete the Liquidation as early as anticipated. As a result of this, to cover a portion of the further costs likely to be incurred, the Liquidators requested the member's approval for the Liquidation fee to be limited to £11,500 plus VAT.

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The enclosed summary of work undertaken details total time costs to date, totalling £29,056, against which fees of £11,500 have been drawn. It is anticipated that a further £500 of time costs will be incurred closing the case, bringing total time costs to £29,556 for the work undertaken between 13 May 2014 and 22 November 2016. Therefore, I anticipate unrecovered time costs will amount to £18,056.

The average hourly charge for dealing with this case is £153 08

2.2 Professional Fees

As previously reported, a payment of £250 plus VAT has been made in respect of the preparation and submission of the pre Liquidation P11D. In addition, £900 plus VAT has been paid in respect to the preparation of accounts and corporation tax returns for the accounting period to 13 May 2014. £600 plus VAT has been paid in respect of post Liquidation tax submission and for assistance in the claim for the S455 tax refund. These amounts have been paid to PKF Cooper Parry Group Limited.

I can confirm that following the member's approval, a further £1,020 plus VAT has been paid in respect of preparation of corporation tax return and computation for the year ended 13 May 2015, as well as preparation and submission of forms P11D for the tax year 5 April 2015 and 5 April 2016

2 3 Specific Bond

Our firm has paid the premium in respect of the Specific Penalty Bond amounting to £394 plus VAT, as required by statute. This has been paid as an expense of the Liquidation

2.4 Statutory Advertising

I can confirm that £338 plus VAT has been paid in respect of the London Gazette statutory notices, including the publication of notice of the final meeting of members

2 5 Corporation Tax

I can confirm an amount of £101 has been paid in respect of Corporation Tax arising on post Liquidation income

2 6 Bank Charges

An amount of £50 has been paid in respect of bank charges

3 UNSECURED CREDITORS

As previously reported, the statutory notice to creditors did not result in any unforeseen claims. Payment has been made to settle pre Liquidation professional fees of £4,620 including VAT, the Class 1a National Insurance liability of £8,205 has also been paid in full. We are not aware of any further liabilities.
