Basis of preparing the financial statements

All service charge monies received from the residents of 4 Windmill Road, Wimbledon, London, SW19 5NQ are held on trust for the residents.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

The company was dormant throughout the current year and previous year.
