2 Liquidator's actions since the last report

- 2.1 This report should be read in conjunction with my previous progress reports and my receipts and payments account which is attached as Appendix 1; please note that the figures are shown net of VAT.
- 2.2 My receipts and payments account confirms that realisations are not significantly different to the estimated statement of affairs amounts.
- 2.3 As advised in my previous annual report, we have been working with Solicitors, Howes Percival LLP, to recover information and supporting documentation from Mr Clement in relation to transactions from the Company bank account.
- 2.4 An offer of settlement has since been received however not agreed by the liquidator.

Other matters

2.5 In addition to my responsibility to realise the Company's assets, I am required to comply with various legislative and best practice obligations and deadlines. These obligations include filing of documents with the Registrar of Companies, ensuring that all receipts and payments are promptly dealt with, and proper accounting records are maintained. In addition, I am required to undertake periodic case reviews to monitor progress, advise creditors of the liquidation and record all claims received. Furthermore, I am obliged to deal with any other day to day matters that may arise during the liquidation.

3 Investigation into the affairs of the Company

- 3.1 One of the responsibilities the liquidator's has is to review the Company's books and records together with any information provided by creditors to establish if there are any areas which may warrant further investigations. The purpose of these investigations is to establish whether there is the possibility of making further recoveries for the benefit of creditors.
- 3.2 Following my initial review, I identified an overdrawn director's loan account and recovery of the same remains ongoing.
- 3.3 A further responsibility of the liquidator is to report to the Secretary of State on any matters that come to his attention that could lead him to conclude that any past or present director may be unfit to be

involved with managing the affairs of a company in the future. This report is confidential and it is a legal requirement that I do not disclose the content of this report.

4 Creditors and dividend prospects

Floating charge creditor and the prescribed part

4.1 The Company has not given any floating charges over its assets and therefore the prescribed part provisions do not apply.

Unsecured creditors

4.2 Whilst I have received a few claims from unsecured creditors, I have not incurred the costs of adjudicating on these claims. Based on current information, regrettably, there is little likelihood of any funds being available to pay a distribution to unsecured creditors.

5 Liquidator's remuneration

- 5.1 Changes to charge out rates during the period of this report are detailed in appendix 3.
- 5.2 My remuneration was approved by creditors on 13 January 2017 following the passing of a resolution at the creditors' decision procedure convened for the purpose of considering the liquidator's remuneration
- 5.3 The liquidator's remuneration is to be paid on a time costs basis and is capped at £13,470.00 plus expenses and VAT, in accordance with the fee estimate circulated to creditors.
- 5.1 My total time costs to 18 December 2021 amount to £20,848.50, which represents 140.27 hours at an average charge out rate of £148.63; this includes £2,919.50 which represents 13.5 hours at an average charge out rate of £216.26 per hour incurred during the period since my last report and 18 December 2021.
- 5.2 Since the date of my last report I have not drawn any fees. A schedule of my time costs incurred to date is attached as Appendix 2.
- 5.3 As you will see, the estimate of fees which has been provided to creditors has already been exceeded.

 I will be reporting to creditors further on this matter in due course.
- 5.4 For the benefit of creditors, the Association of Business and Recovery Professionals publish 'A Creditors' Guide to Liquidators' Fees'. This document is available at the following website address, https://www.r3.org.uk/technical-library/england-wales/technical-guidance/fees/. A hard copy of this document can be obtained on request from our office.

7 Further information

A request must be in writing, and may be made either by a secured creditor, or by an unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of unsecured creditors, or the permission of the court.
- 7.2 Any secured or unsecured creditor, if they consider that the liquidator's fees are excessive, or that the basis of those fees is inappropriate or that the expenses incurred are excessive, may make an application to the court if at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors agree. An application must be made within 8 weeks of receipt of this report.
