- c Dormant companies acting as an agent for any person must state that they have so acted in Section 3
- d A fee or penalty raised on the company for the payment of an annual return fee, change of name fee, reregistration fee, or late filing penalty may be omitted from the company records and this DCA if the payment was made by a third party without any right of reimbursement
