1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- 1.1 I, Shane Biddlecombe of HJS Recovery (UK) Ltd, 12-14 Carlton Place, Southampton, Hampshire SO15 2EA, was appointed as Joint Liquidator of Black Label Trading Limited (the Company) on 13 November 2014 together with my colleague Gordon Johnston. This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 12 November 2017 (the Period).
- 1.2 The trading address of the Company was 3 The Fountain Centre, Lensbury Avenue, Imperial Wharf London SW6 2TW.
- 1.3 The registered office of the Company was changed to c/o HJS Recovery, 12-14 Carlton Place, Southampton, Hampshire SO15 2EA and its registered number is 07096135.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period, with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values together with a cumulative account since my appointment.
- 2.2 There are no further assets to realise in the liquidation.

3 Outstanding Matters

3.1 As previously reported the final pre-appointment corporation tax return was not filed correctly. Despite numerous correspondence with HM Revenue & Customs this return still needs to be filed electronically and I am continuing to liaise with the Company's former accountants in respect of this matter. Whilst there is no tax liability for this period the delay in submitting the return has resulted in a penalty of £200 which has been paid as an expense of the liquidation.

4 Creditors' Claims

Secured & Preferential Creditors

4.1 There were no secured or preferential creditors in the liquidation.

Unsecured Creditors

4.2 The director's Declaration of Solvency indicated that the company had one creditor of £375. No claims have been received from creditors other than the penalty of £200 raised in respect of the outstanding tax return which has been paid as a n expense of the liquidation during this period.

5 Liquidator's Remuneration

- 5.1 The members approved that the basis of the Liquidator's remuneration be fixed as a set amount of £10,000 plus VAT inclusive of disbursements.
- 5.2 The Liquidators have drawn £8,400plus VAT against the total set fee approved by the members.

- 7.2 Any members with at least 10% of the total voting rights of all the members having the right to vote at general meetings of the Company may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report, make an application to court on the grounds that, in all the circumstances, the basis fixed for the Liquidator's remuneration is inappropriate and/or the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred by the Liquidator, as set out in this progress report, are excessive.

8 Next Report

8.1 I am required to provide a further report on the progress of the liquidation within two months of the end of the second anniversary of the liquidation, unless I have concluded matters prior to this, in which case I will write again with my proposed final account.
