1 Introduction

- Paul Walker, of Harrisons Business Recovery and Insolvency Limited, 102 Sunlight House, Quay Street, Manchester M£ 3JZ together with Lewis Onions of Lewis Onions Solicitors Limited, Allum House, 36 Water Street, Birmingham B3 1HP, were appointed as Joint Liquidators of Darwin Solicitors (Shropshire) Limited t/a Darwin Matthews Solicitors (the Company) on 10 March 2015.
- 1.2 By virtue of a Block Transfer Order, Paul Boyle of Harrisons Business Recovery and Insolvency Limited replaced Paul Walker as Joint Liquidator on 18 August 2016.
- 1.3 The trading address of the Company was 5 Swan Hill Court, Shrewsbury, Shropshire, SY1 1NP. The business traded under the name Darwin Matthews Solicitors.
- 1.4 The registered office of the Company was changed to 102 Sunlight House, Quay Street, Manchester, M3 3JZ and its registered number is 07117031.
- 1.5 As the liquidation is now complete, I am required to provide a progress report covering the period since my last progress report. This is my final report in the liquidation and covers the period from 10 March 2019 to 17 February 2020 (the Period).
- 1.6 Information about the way that we will use, and store personal data on insolvency appointments can be found at http://harrisons.uk.com/privacy-policy. If you are unable to download this, please contact us and a hard copy will be provided to you.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 This section of the report provides creditors with an overview of the progress made in the Period, together with information on the overall outcome of the liquidation.
- 2.2 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period with a comparison to the directors' statement of affairs values, together with a cumulative account since my appointment also at Appendix A, which provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidators.

Administration (including statutory compliance & reporting)

As noted in my previous reports, the Liquidator must comply with certain statutory obligations under the Insolvency Act 1986 and other related legislation. Details about the work undertaken in this regard has been outlined previously and I would confirm that in the final period of the liquidation, the only matters that have affected the costs in this area to any particular extent are the final collection of work in progress and closure formalities.

Realisation of Assets

Work In Progress

- 2.4 The Statement of Affairs showed work in progress with an uncertain realisable value. The Joint Liquidator, Lewis Onions of Lewis Onions Solicitors Limited, has collected the sum of £23,392.60.
- 2.5 Since our last report, the remaining files requiring settlement at Lewis Onions Solicitors have been finalised.

Book Debts

2.6 During the Period, the Joint Liquidators have continued to pursue the book debts outstanding to the Company. A further sum of £12,659.69 was recovered in the Period, bringing total

realisations from book debts to £31,656.54. This compares to the Statement of Affairs figure of £15,244.92 at the start of the liquidation and there will be no further realisations in this regard.

Director's Loan Account

- 2.7 As previously reported, a claim was submitted in the bankruptcy estate of the Director for an outstanding director's loan amount due to the Company of £56,636.00.
- 2.8 In the latest report, the Director's Trustee in bankruptcy advised that a dividend would be unlikely from the bankruptcy estate. Accordingly, no realisations are expected to be received in this regard.
- 2.9 There have been no further realisations in the Period save for bank interest of £8.04.
- 2.10 It is anticipated that the work the Liquidators and their staff have undertaken to date may bring a financial benefit to creditors. This may be a distribution to secured creditors of the Company only (from which a Prescribed Part fund may be derived for the benefit of unsecured creditors) or may, depending on realisations and the extent of any 3rd party security, result in a distribution to the preferential and/or unsecured creditors of the Company.

Creditors (claims and distributions)

- 2.11 Further information on the outcome for creditors in this case can be found at section 4 of this report. The Liquidators are not only required to deal with correspondence and claims from unsecured creditors, but also those of any secured and preferential creditors of the Company. This may involve separate reporting to any secured creditor and dealing with distributions from asset realisations caught under their security, most typically a debenture as well as dealing with the general handling of communications with stakeholders, such as customers and suppliers.
- 2.12 The above work will not necessarily bring any financial benefit to creditors generally and the more creditors there are on an assignment, the higher the resultant cost will usually be, however the Liquidators are required by statute to undertake this work.

Investigations

Since my last progress report I would advise that no further asset realisations have come to light that may be pursued by me for the benefit of creditors

3 Outcome for Creditors

Secured Creditors

The Royal bank of Scotland plc holds a fixed and floating charge over the Company's assets. At the date of the liquidation the indebtedness to the secured creditor was estimated at £46,754.42.

Unsecured Creditors

3.2 I received claims totalling £595,229 from 31 creditors.

I can confirm that the realisations are insufficient to declare a dividend to the unsecured creditors.

4 Joint Liquidators' Remuneration

- 4.1 The basis of the Liquidators' remuneration was fixed by reference to the time properly spent by him and his staff in managing the Liquidation.
- 4.2 My time costs for the Period are £4,393. This represents 19.2 hours at an average rate of £228.80 per hour. Lewis Onions time costs for the Period are £1,414. This represents 10.1 hours at an average rate of £140 per hour.
- 4.3 Attached as Appendix B is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during the Period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent by me in managing the liquidation.
- 4.4 A narrative explanation of the work undertaken by the Liquidators during the Period can be found at section 2 of this report.
- 4.5 Also attached as Appendix B is a cumulative Time Analysis for the period from 10 March 2015 to 17 February 2020 which provides details of my time costs since the commencement of the liquidation.
- The cumulative time costs incurred by Harrisons to 17 February 2020 are £48,618. This represents 241.47 hours at an average rate of £201.34 per hour. A sum of £17,633.07 has been paid on account of these time costs, no further fees will be drawn.
- 4.7 The cumulative time costs incurred by Lewis Onions to 17 February 2020 are £64,750. This represents 278.2 hours at an average rate of £232.75 per hour. A sum of £21,536.92 has been paid on account of these time cost, no further fees will be drawn.
- 4.8 Attached as Appendix C is additional information in relation to the Liquidators' fees and the expenses and disbursements incurred in the liquidation.

5 Creditors' rights

- Within 21 days of the receipt of this report, a secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors) may request in writing that the Liquidators provide further information about his remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in this progress report.
- 5.2 Any secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors) may within 8 weeks of receipt of this progress report make an

application to court on the grounds that, in all the circumstances, the basis fixed for the Liquidators' remuneration is inappropriate and/or the remuneration charged or the expenses incurred by the Liquidators, as set out in this progress report, are excessive.

6 Conclusion

6.1 This report together with final meetings of members and creditors will conclude my administration. Details of the final meetings and resolutions to be considered have been circulated with this report.
