ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION dated 3 December 2018 of the First Applicant, Mary Anne Currie-Smith of 1st Floor, 24 High Street, Whittlesford, Cambridgeshire, CB22 4LT, in her capacity as office-holder of the estates in Annex 2 to this order, and the Second Applicant, W John Kelly of Temple Point, 1 Temple Row, Birmingham, B2 5LG in his capacity as joint liquidator of Great Houghton School Limited as set out in Schedule A to Annex 2 of this order

AND UPON READING the witness statement of the First Applicant dated 3 December 2018

AND UPON READING the statements of the proposed replacement office-holders filed at court, which state they are qualified to act as insolvency practitioners in relation to the estates at Annex 2 and so consent to act

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The County Court proceedings listed in Schedule 1 of Annex 1 to this order be transferred to the High Court, Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Insolvency and Companies List (ChD) for the purpose only of this application and forthwith after the making of this order be transferred back to the County Court from which they came.
- 2. The proceedings in the District Registries listed in Schedule 2 of Annex 1 to this order be transferred to the High Court, Business and Property Courts of England and Wales, Insolvency and Companies List (ChD) for the purpose only of this application and forthwith after the making of this order be transferred back to the District Registry from which they came.
- 3. In respect of the Creditors' Voluntary Liquidations listed in Schedule A of Annex 2 to this order, pursuant to section 108 of the Insolvency Act ("IA"), from the date of this order:
 - a. the First Applicant be removed as joint liquidator of all the cases listed therein;
 - b. the Second Applicant be removed as joint liquidator of Great Houghton School Limited;

- c. the First Respondent be appointed as joint liquidator of the cases in respect of which she is proposed as a replacement in the schedule;
- d. the Fifth Respondent be appointed as joint liquidator of the cases in respect of which he is proposed as a replacement in the schedule;
- e. any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a liquidator may be done by either or both of the liquidators appointed in respect of the companies in the schedule.
- 4. In respect of each Members' Voluntary Liquidation listed in Schedule B of Annex 2 to this order, pursuant to section 108 of the IA, from the date of this order:
 - a. the First Applicant be removed as joint liquidator;
 - b. the Fifth Respondent be appointed as joint liquidator;
 - c. any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a liquidator may be done by either or both of the liquidators appointed in respect of the companies in the schedule.
- 5. In respect of the Administrations listed in Schedule C of Annex 2 to this order, pursuant to paragraphs 63 and 88 of Schedule B1 of the IA, from the date of this order:
 - a. the First Applicant be removed as joint administrator of each administration;
 - b. the Fifth Respondent be appointed as joint administrator of the case in respect of which he is proposed as a replacement in the schedule;
 - c. the Ninth Respondent be appointed as joint administrator of the case in respect of which he is proposed as a replacement in the schedule;
 - d. any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by an administrator may be done by either or both of the administrators appointed in respect of the companies in the schedule.
- 6. In respect of the Bankruptcy listed in Schedule D of Annex 2 to this order, pursuant to sections 298 and 303(2) of the IA, from the date of this order:
 - a. the First Applicant be removed as joint trustee-in-bankruptcy;
 - b. the Fifth Respondent be appointed as joint trustee-in-bankruptcy;

- c. any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a trustee in bankruptcy may be done by either or both of the trustees-in-bankruptcy appointed in respect of the bankrupt in the schedule.
- 7. In respect of the Compulsory Liquidations listed in Schedule E of Annex 2 to this order, pursuant to sections 172(2) and 168(3) of the IA, from the date of this order:
 - a. the First Applicant be removed as joint liquidator;
 - b. the Fifth Respondent be appointed as joint liquidator of the case in respect of which he is proposed as a replacement in the schedule;
 - c. the Eighth Respondent be appointed as joint liquidator of the case in respect of which he is proposed as a replacement in the schedule;
 - d. any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a liquidator may be done by either or both of the liquidators appointed in respect of the companies in the schedule.
- 8. In respect of the Company Voluntary Arrangement listed in Schedule F of Annex 2 to this order, pursuant to section 7(5) of the IA, from the date of this order:
 - a. the First Applicant be removed as joint supervisor;
 - b. the Fifth Respondent be appointed as joint supervisor;
 - c. any act required or authorised under any enactment to be done by a supervisor may be done by either or both of the supervisors appointed in respect of the company in the schedule.
- 9. The creditors of each of the cases in the schedules in Annex 2 of this order be given notice of this order by advertisement in the London Gazette within 14 days of the date of this order in the form of one advertisement for all the cases in Annex 2. The creditors in each case shall be given further notice of this order at the time of the next statutory reporting requirement for each case.
- 10. Any creditor in respect of the companies or persons listed in the schedules in Annex 2 of this order who has an objection to this order shall have 21 days from the date of advertisement in accordance with the preceding paragraph to apply to court to set aside or vary the terms of this

order. Such application shall not affect the transfer of the cases listed in the schedules at Annex 2 to the replacement office-holder until further order of the court.

- 11. The office-holders appointed pursuant to paragraphs 3 to 8 of this order shall give notice to the Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy in respect of the cases listed at Annex 2 of the terms of this order as soon as reasonably practicable.
- 12. The Applicants shall deliver a copy of the order to the registrar of companies as soon as reasonably practicable in respect of the removal of them as office-holders for the cases listed in Schedules A, B and E of Annex 2 to this order.
- 13. The First Applicant shall deliver a copy of the order to the registrar of companies within 5 business days of the copy of the order being delivered to her, in respect of her removal as office-holder for the cases listed in Schedules C of Annex 2 to this order.
- 14. Further to paragraphs 3 to 5 and 7 to 8 of this order:
 - a. Within 14 days of this order, the First and Fifth Respondents shall deliver notice of their appointments to the registrar of companies in respect of the cases in Schedules A and B of Annex 2 to this order.
 - b. Within 7 days of a copy of this order being delivered to them, the Fifth and Ninth Respondents shall deliver notice of their appointments to the registrar of companies in respect of the cases listed in Schedule C of Annex 2 to this order.
 - c. As soon as reasonably practicable, the Fifth and Eighth Respondents shall deliver notice of their appointments to the registrar of companies in respect of the cases listed in Schedule E of Annex 2 to this order.
 - d. As soon as reasonably practicable, the Fifth Respondent shall deliver notice of his appointment to the registrar of companies in respect of the case listed in Schedule F of Annex 2 to this order.
- 15. The First Applicant shall file a copy of this order in the courts listed in the schedules at Annex 1 to this order.

- 16. In respect of the companies at schedule C of Annex 2 to this order, the First Applicant shall receive her discharge from liability under paragraph 98 of Schedule B1 of the IA 28 days after giving notice to creditors in accordance with paragraph 9 of this order.
- 17. The costs of this application shall be borne in equal shares by each of the estates in the schedules at Annex 2 to this order, provided that no estate shall bear an amount exceeding 10% of the realisations in that estate. No order as to costs.
