- In respect of those Bankruptcies where the orders were made prior to 6 April 2010, the Applicant shall give written notice to each and every creditor within 21 days of the date of this Order
- Liberty to each creditor/member/director (as the case may be) of each Liquidation,
 Voluntary Arrangement, and Bankruptcy (as the case may be) to apply to vary or
 discharge this Order within 28 days of receipt of the notices directed to be sent under
 paragraph 10 above
- The costs of the Application in so far as attributable to an individual insolvency should be fixed and paid in the ordinary way as remuneration costs and expenses of such insolvency. Costs which cannot be attributed to an individual insolvency proceeding should be apportioned equally between the insolvencies in the schedule so long as the costs apportioned to each individual estate shall not exceed 10% of the assets realised in the particular insolvency or voluntary arrangement.
- 14 Compliance with Rule 7 10D(3) of the Insolvency Rules 1986 is varied so that lodging of a certified copy of this Order, once sealed, with each Court is deemed to be compliant with that Rule
- Service of Notice of the Application upon the Respondent is dispensed with
