1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

At the year end the company reported a deficiency in assets of £17,671 (2015 - £14,344). The company meets its day to day working capital requirements through the continued support of its directors. The directors have undertaken not to withdraw their support within twelve months from the date of signature of these financial statements and therefore consider it appropriate to prepare these financial statements on a going concern basis.

1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

1.3 Investments

Fixed asset investments are stated at cost less provision for diminution in value.
