In accordance with section 516 of the Companies Act 2006, we write to notify you of our resignation as auditor of Kazakhmys Projects Finance Ltd ('the Company'). This resignation takes effect from the date on which you receive this letter.

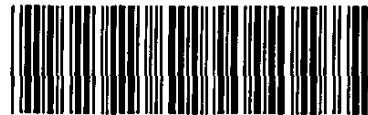
