Open meetings were held for families caring for a family member with a learning disability. This enabled families to meet other families in similar situations to themselves, discuss issues that were concerning them and gain information and listen to speakers invited to the meetings to talk about specific issues.

We had a celebration meeting this year to celebrate our 10<sup>th</sup> year as a network for our families, at this meeting we had a number of providers who offer support to carers attending each provider gave a short presentation and had a market stall with information for our families, this was very well received.

We hosted 3 events along with Essex Mencap to facilitate discussions between our families and the local authority about the current system and what has changed and needs to change.

We are actively involved in a number of initiatives working coproductively with our local authority to ensure our families voices are heard and influence service provision, these include the support for carers workstream, specilaist health provision and transforming care workstream and introducing the thinking ahead template to help families to plan for the future.

The Network continues to ensure the views of family carers are being heard in the right places. We provide family carer representatives to participate in events or sit on decision making boards.
