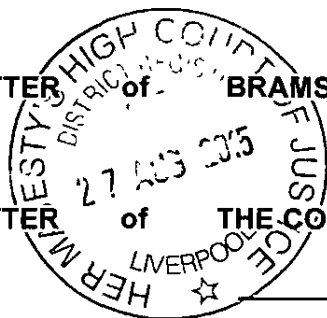

- (A) immediately upon restoration of the name of the Company to the Register of Companies inform the Registrar of Companies of the title and Court reference number of the said litigation referred to in paragraph 7 of the Witness Statement of Arpana Kapoor dated the 17th April 2015

- (B) unless the said litigation is completed in the interim, at 6 monthly intervals from the date of the order serve on the Registrar of Companies a full and sufficient Witness Statement setting out what steps have been taken to progress the said litigation

AND UPON the solicitors for the Claimant and for the Registrar of Companies ("the Defendant") both consenting to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT

- (1) the name of the above named Bramshall Inn Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 07533109 Limited
- (3) an Office Copy of the Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the Company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

(5) in the event that the Claimant fails to comply with undertaking (B) above the Registrar of Companies be at liberty to commence strike off action in respect of the Company without further notice to the Claimant
