2. Progress of the Liquidation in the period of the Report

Instructions were issued to this Practice to assist in winding-up the Company under a creditors' voluntary liquidation on 20th May 2013 and the appointment of the Liquidator was made on 7th June 2013

The Liquidator's progress in dealing with the assets of the Company is detailed in section (3) below

The Liquidator was obliged to investigate the affairs and dealings of the Directors of the Company and to submit a Report on his findings to the Department for Business Innovation and Skills, in accordance with the requirements of the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986

This Report has been submitted, however I am not permitted to disclose the contents of the same

The Liquidator's enquires in this regard have now been concluded and no further action will be taken in the absence of additional concerns

I have in addition undertaken enquiries in accordance with the best practice directives of Statement of Insolvency Practice 2 "Investigations by Office Holders in Administrations and Insolvent Liquidations" to ascertain whether there are potential areas of recovery or matters of public interest requiring further more detailed investigation. I have noted no areas of concern in this regard

Creditor claims received to date have been dealt with as detailed in section (5) below

3. Liquidator's Receipts & Payments Account

Attached is an account of our Receipts and Payments for the period covered by this report from which you will note there was a balance held of £325 80

Asset realisations

You will note from the attached Receipts and Payments Account that realisations made in the period covered by this report consist of £325.70 received on account in respect of cash at bank together with minimal bank deposit interest earned on the Estate account of £0.10

Unrealised assets

Creditors will recall that the Statement of Affairs showed assets consisting of tools and office equipment together with a motor vehicle. Agents were instructed to deal with the sale of these assets and whilst a sale to a concern associated by common directorship was agreed, to date no funds have been received. This matter is under review.

Expenses paid

Due to minimal funds held in the Estate account no expenses have been made during the period of this Report

Expenses accrued

The Liquidator has been obliged to discharge certain expenses from the resources of Yerrill Murphy These expenses consist of £30 plus VAT in respect of a specific bond, together with statutory advertising of £253 80 plus VAT. In addition the Liquidator has unrealised time costs as detailed below

4 Liquidator's Remuneration

At the initial meeting of creditors it was resolved that the Liquidator's remuneration be fixed by reference to his time costs with authority for such fees to be drawn as, when and if funds permit. To date, no funds have been drawn

The Liquidator has incurred time costs of £3,217 50 consisting of 19 70 hours at an average charge out rate of £163 32 per hour in the period covered by this report. A breakdown of the Liquidator's time costs for the period 7th June 2013 to 6th June 2014 is attached for your information.

We would draw your attention to the provisions of rule 4 49E of the Rules

Within 21 days of receipt of this report, any secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question), or with the permission of the court upon an application made within that period of 21 days, any unsecured creditor, may make a request in writing to the Liquidator for further information about remuneration or expenses detailed in this Report

The Liquidator should, within 14 days of receipt of the request, provide all of the information asked for However if the Liquidator consider that the time or cost of preparation of the information would be excessive, or disclosure of the information would be prejudicial to the conduct of the liquidation or might reasonably be expected to lead to violence against any person, or the liquidator is subject to an obligation of confidentiality in respect of the information, he may withhold the information and give reasons for not providing the same

If the Liquidator fails to provide the information within the 14 days of the initial request, or gives reasons for withholding the information, then a creditor may apply to the court within the ensuing 21 days and the Court may make such Order as it see fit

We would additionally draw your attention to the provisions of rule 4 131 of the Rules

Any secured creditor, or any unsecured creditor with either the concurrence of 10% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question), or with the permission of the Court, may apply to the Court for one of the following Orders

- a) An Order reducing the amount of remuneration that the Liquidators are entitled to charge
- b) An Order fixing the basis of remuneration at a reduced rate or amount
- c) An Order changing the basis of remuneration
- d) An Order that some or all of the remuneration or expenses in question be treated as not being expenses of the Liquidation
- e) An Order that the Liquidator or the Liquidator's personal representative pay to the Company the amount of the excess of remuneration or expenses or such part of the excess as the Court may specify

Alternatively the Court may make any other Order that it thinks just but Orders under 'b' or 'c' above may be made only in respect of periods after the period of this report

Any application must be made within eight weeks of receipt of the first report in which the remuneration and/or expenses in question are detailed, although the Court may extend the period by such further period as the court thinks just

Creditors' attention is drawn to the Guide to Liquidators' Fees as circularised with the Notice convening the initial meeting of creditors, dated 20th May 2013, and to the charge out rates detailed therein. A further copy can be made available on request

5. <u>Dividend Prospects and Creditors Claims</u>

There were no registered charges and no anticipated claims of a preferential status. In the period covered by this report, no claims of either status have been received

The Statement of Affairs lodged in the proceedings disclosed five potential unsecured creditors totalling £16,422 05. To date we have received two claims totalling £18,087 31. Claims received have yet to be formally agreed and will only be agreed in the unlikely event that funds are sufficient to facilitate a distribution to the unsecured creditors.

Creditors with claims outstanding will be invited to submit same in the unlikely event that a dividend distribution becomes available

6. Ongoing Issues

The Liquidator continues to monitor the position in relation to the sale of the Company's assets
