To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept or assume responsibility to anyone other than the board of directors, as a body, for our work or for this report.

#### Basis of report

Our work was carried out having regard to Factsheet 172 'Residential service charge accounts' published jointly by the professional accountancy bodies with ARMA and RICS. In summary, the procedures we carried out with respect to the service charge accounts were

- 1 We obtained the service charge accounts and checked whether the figures in the accounts were extracted correctly from the accounting records maintained by or on behalf of the board of directors,
- 2 We checked, based on a sample, whether entries in the accounting records were supported by receipts, other documentation or evidence that we inspected, and
- 3 We checked whether the balance of service charge monies for this property shown on page 4 of the service charge accounts agreed or reconciled to the bank statements for the accounts in which the funds are held

Because the above procedures do not constitute either an audit or a review made in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland) or International Standards on Review Engagements, we do not express any assurance on the service charge accounts other than making the factual statements set out below

Had we performed additional procedures or had we performed an audit or review of the financial statements in accordance with International Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland) or International Standards on Review Engagements, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you
