#### Mission/vision

Our mission is to provide a good quality service, ensuring safe and stimulating play opportunities and childcare for working or studying parents/carers, during out of school hours.

Our fun and exciting new combination of performing arts workshops, which gives children & young people a safe place to reatively express themselves, develop skills in theatre, dance, singing and music. 2 Da Stage aims to install self-esteem and confidence in all its members.

The club offers an after school service between 4pm-6pm as well as a holiday playscheme provision during school holidays between 8am-6pm based at Ark Academy in Wembley. Our performing arts classes take place on Saturday afternoons and are based at Bridge Park Complex.

The after school club and holiday playscheme offers a safe and stimulating environment for children to learn through play outside of school hours. Interactive focused activities are planned to strategically develop children's social, physical, emotional, language, intellectual and creative skills. This is achieved through structured and free play, cooking, arts & crafts, sports, music, drama, dance, reading, storytelling, imaginative play and offsite trips.

#### **REVIEW OF DEVELOPMENTS, ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS**

2 Da Stage continues to partner with Ark Academy for the 6th year running and provides a reliable, high quality childcare service during term time and school holidays. Our after-school service benefits many families living in the Brent area and our school holidays service is used by hundreds of parents/ carers from across the borough and outside the borough too.

The organisation continues to provide voluntary training experience for young people that have a particular interest in pursuing a career in childcare. Young people are able to apply for a position with us, normally during all school holidays, and use us as a reference for their CV and to also gain experience of the workplace.

We are now working in partnership with the Yellow Pavilion during school holidays. The Yellow Pavilion is a brand new social space in Wembley Park. The building is located across the road from Wembley Stadium and minutes away from the Civic Centre. This fantastic location enables hundreds of working parents to easily get information about our service and how they can go about registering.

2 Da Stage are now members of the Young Brent Foundation. We are amongst a number of other Brent based organisation that are under the umbrella of the YBF. A small grants fund was awarded to us to spend on equipment to improve our service. We are also members of the YBF consortium and are applying for big bids that benefits the children and young people of this borough.

We are now members of The London Youth and are working towards gaining a quality assurance mark. This mark will recognise our service as being excellent.

The club has produced a website www.2dastage.com making it much easier to gain information about the activities of the club, prices and how to register. Information about trips, our latest Ofsted report are available on the website. Children can complete questionnaires and give feedback to staff about which activities and trips they have enjoyed and suggest activities to staff. Parents can find information on how to get support with applying for help with their childcare fees.

# After school club/ playscheme

2 Da Stage Performing Arts & Childcare service has a focus of ensuring children gain the necessary development skills needed to become well rounded citizens. These skills are passed over to the children through planned activities and play. All children in our care must take part in activities that develop their social, physical, linguistics, Intellectual, creative and emotional skills. Although children may float from activity to activity, there is a specific learning outcome that playworks strive to achieve in their activities and games with the children.

The service is accessible Monday- Friday from 3.40 to 6pm at Ark Academy and from 8am-6pm during all school holidays at Yellow Pavilion. Children regularly go on trips which include cinema, bowling, theme parks, sea side, museums, park, library, zoos, safari parks and more.

#### **Performing Arts**

Our dance classes have relaunched this year and take place every Friday evening. We are working in partnership with Chalkhill Community Centre to deliver these classes for children and young people aged between 7-19 years old.

#### ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following accounting policies have been used consistently in dealing with items, which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

#### Basis of Preparation ...

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP), "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of recommended practice" published in March 2005 and applicable accounting standards. Where appropriate comparative figures have been restated.

#### **Tangible Fixed Assets**

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost. Depreciation of tangible fixed assets is provided on a straight line basis applied to original cost at rates estimated to write the assets off over their expected useful lives.

#### **Incoming Resources**

Donations and grants receivable are recognised in the period in which they become available to the charity. Other income is included in the financial statements on an accruals basis.

#### **Allocation of Expenditure**

Expenditure has been classified as direct charitable expenditure where substantially all the costs incurred relate to the direct charitable activities of the company.

Support costs have been apportioned between direct charitable expenditure and other expenditure on the basis of the amount of staff time estimated to be spent on each activity.

Expenditure has been classified as governance costs where the costs incurred relate to direct board costs, consultancy fees, professional fees, Independent review costs and senior management staff costs allocated on estimated time spent on the statutory accounts
