My Social Enterprise assists people who are experiencing homelessness to move into supported and unsupported accommdoation—this year we have assisted over 20 clients to move into supported accommodation through our partnership with the London Housing Trust

We also provide work experience for those clients who are in tempory and supported accommodation. This year a £10,000 donation from Helping Hand Housing Services Ltd (HHHS) to provide assistance for 2 full financial years. We have alocated this to be £5000 for each year.

We have provided our clients with over £19,000 to support their voluntary work. This provided approximately 1000 days of vountary work experience with London Housing Trust (LHT)
