NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD 1 MARCH 2016 TO 31 JULY 2017

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Atpledge Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

The company's principal place of business is 20 Market Square, Northampton, NN1 2DL.

The financial statements are presented in Sterling, which this is the functional currency of the company, and rounded to the nearest \pounds .

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

These financial statements cover the period from 1 March 2016 to 31 July 2017. The period of account was extended in order to provide the company with more time to conclude court proceedings in regards to two potentially irrecoverable loans.

The significant accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented unless otherwise stated.

At the balance sheet date, the company has net liabilities of £124,300 and retained losses of £343,300. In addition to this, two loans made to customers are part of ongoing court proceedings and may not be fully recoverable. This indicates that the company may not be able to continue as a going concern, however these financial statements do not include the necessary adjustments were this the case as the directors believe that they will be successful in recovering a significant proportion of the loans outstanding. Further detail with regards to the potentially irrecoverable loans has been provided in note 10.

Preparation of consolidated financial statements

The financial statements contain information about Atpledge Limited as an individual company and do not contain consolidated financial information as the parent of a group. The company has taken the option under Section 399 of the Companies Act 2006 not to prepare consolidated financial statements.

Related party exemption

The company has taken advantage of exemption, under the terms of Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland', not to disclose related party transactions with wholly owned subsidiaries within the group.

Turnover

Turnover comprises interest earned on secured loans and is recognised in the accounts in accordance with the terms of the individual loan agreements, i.e. the term of the loan and the interest rate.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Fixtures and fittings - 20% on cost Computer equipment - 33 1/3 % on cost

Investments in subsidiaries

Investments in subsidiary undertakings are recognised at cost.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES - continued

Taxation

Taxation for the period comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the period end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.

Leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to profit or loss on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

Pension costs and other post-retirement benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. Contributions payable to the company's pension scheme are charged to profit or loss in the period to which they relate.

Debtors and creditors receivable/payable within one year

Debtors and creditors with no stated interest rate and receivable or payable within one year are recorded at the transaction price. Any losses arising from impairment are recognised in the profit and loss account in other administrative expenses.

Creditors payable after one year are also recognised at the transaction price. The fair value of these liabilities is not considered to be materially different to transaction price.

Employee benefits

When employees have rendered service to the company, short-term employee benefits to which the employees are entitled are recognised at the undiscounted amount expected to be paid in exchange for that service.
