**NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
for the Year Ended 31 May 2017**

1. STATUTORY INFORMATION

Bish Bosh Limited is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales. The company's registered number and registered office address can be found on the Company Information page.

The presentation currency of the financial statement is the Pound Sterling (£) which is the functional currency of the company and rounded to the nearest £.

The significant accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. These policies have been consistently applied to all years presented unless otherwise stated.

2. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A "Small Entities" of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Transition to Financial Reporting Standard 102

The date of transition for the Financial Reporting Standard 102 purposes was 1 June 2015. As part of the transition process, there have been no changes to accounting policies. In addition, there have been no transitional adjustments necessary to reconcile equity determined in accordance with the previous financial reporting framework to equity determined in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard 102 as at the date of transition and at the end of the latest period presented in the company's most recent financial statements determined in accordance with its previous financial reporting framework. No transitional adjustments have been required, in addition, to reconcile the profit or loss determined in accordance with the company's previous financial reporting framework for the latest period in the company's most recent annual financial statements to its profit or loss determined in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard 102 for the same period.

Turnover

Turnover represents the sales of services net of value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Computer equipment	- 25% on reducing balance
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Taxation

Taxation for the year comprises current and deferred tax. Tax is recognised in the Income Statement, except to the extent that it relates to items recognised in other comprehensive income or directly in equity.

Current or deferred taxation assets and liabilities are not discounted.

Current tax is recognised at the amount of tax payable using the tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date.

Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date.

Timing differences arise from the inclusion of income and expenses in tax assessments in periods different from those in which they are recognised in financial statements. Deferred tax is measured using tax rates and laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the year end and that are expected to apply to the reversal of the timing difference.

Unrelieved tax losses and other deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that it is probable that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits.
