NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MAY 2014

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The company has net current liabilities of £217,374 and net liabilities of £149,335. Included within other creditors due within one year is an amount of £56,780 due to the directors Mr AR J Bird and Mr R Germanus-Kunda. The directors will not seek repayment of these amounts to the detriment of other creditors and will continue to provide the company with financial support as and when required. The directors therefore consider it appropriate to prepare the accounts on a going concern basis.

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

Turnover

Turnover represents net invoiced sales of goods, excluding value added tax.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery etc

- 25% on reducing balance and 10% on cost

Deferred tax

The charge for taxation is based on the results for the year and takes into account taxation deferred because of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. In accordance with Financial Reporting Standard 19, provision is made for deferred tax in respect of all timing differences that have been originated but not reversed by the balance sheet date. Deferred tax assets are recognised when it is more likely than not that the asset will be recovered. Deferred tax is measured using rates that have been enacted or substantially enacted by the balance sheet date. Deferred tax balances are not discounted.

Hire purchase and leasing commitments

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.
