### LIQUIDATOR'S ACTIONS SINCE APPOINTMENT

Since my last report time has been spent liaising with the resigned Liquidator regarding the outstanding monies and records.

### RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ACCOUNT

No funds have been received and therefore I have not attached my Receipts and Payments account for the period 5 February 2016 to 4 February 2018.

### **ASSETS**

The Director's report advised that there were no assets or debtors and any remaining stock had been water damaged and had no value.

### Bank Interest

During the course of the liquidation, no funds have been provided. When funds are received they will be placed in an interest bearing account.

### LIABILITIES

### Secured Creditors

An examination of the Company's mortgage register held by the Registrar of Companies, showed that the Company has no current charges over its assets.

The legislation requires that if the company has created a floating charge after 15 September 2003, a prescribed part of the company's net property (i.e. the money that would otherwise be available to the

charge holder) should be ring-fenced for distribution to unsecured creditors. In this case there were no secured creditors and accordingly the prescribed part provisions do not apply.

### Preferential Creditors

As the Company had no employees, no preferential claims were anticipated and none have been received.

### Unsecured Creditors

Thirty-two unsecured creditors, including HMRC, were listed in the Statement of affairs, owed an estimated £695,751.46. Five previously omitted creditors have submitted claims totalling £65,651.93 and to date total unsecured claims are £400,017.62.

The HMRC daims in the Statement of Affairs were uncertain. HMRC have submitted daims in respect of VAT in the sum of £1,759 and Corporation Tax of £7,652.04.

### **DIVIDEND PROSPECTS**

### Secured Creditors

The company has no secured creditors.

### Preferential Creditors

The company has no preferential creditors.

### Unsecured Creditors

Based on current information it is unlikely that a dividend will be paid to unsecured creditors as the funds realised have been used to pay preferential creditors and to meet the expenses of the Liquidation.

## Prescribed Part

The company did not grant a floating charge to any creditor and accordingly the prescribed part provisions will not apply.

### INVESTIGATION INTO THE AFFAIRS OF THE COMPANY

I undertook an initial investigation into the Company's affairs to establish whether there were any potential asset recoveries or conduct matters that justified further investigation, taking account of the public interest, potential recoveries, the funds likely to be available to fund an investigation, and the costs involved. There were no matters that justified further investigation in the circumstances of this appointment.

### PRE-APPOINTMENT REMUNERATION

The creditors approved the payment of a fee of £5,000 plus VAT and disbursements for assistance with the preparation of the statement of affairs and producing and circulating the notices for the meetings of members and creditors, prior to my appointment at the meeting of creditors held on 5 February 2016. I am liaising with the former joint Liquidator regarding payment.

### LIQUIDATOR'S REMUNERATION

My remuneration was previously authorised by creditors at a meeting held on 5 February 2016 to be drawn on a time costs basis. The time spent to date is 56hours at a cost of £5,235 net of VAT, of which 13hrs12mins have been charged in the last twelve months at a cost of £1,343 net of VAT. Time is charged in minimum units of six minutes.
