This is the Joint Liquidators final report. The purpose of this report is to detail our acts and dealings as Joint Liquidators and should be read in conjunction with the report of the initial meeting of creditors and subsequent annual reports.

### 1. BACKGROUND

lan Michael Rose and myself were appointed Joint Liquidators on 25 March 2014 following meetings of the members and creditors of the Company.

### 2. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ACCOUNT

We attach an account of receipts and payments for the final period and cumulatively for the whole period of the liquidation.

### 3. ASSET REALISATIONS

### Assets

The asset of the Company, being goodwill, had an uncertain book value and estimated to realise value in the Statement of Affairs. An offer was received from the director, Mr Andrew Gernham, on 25 March 2014, for the sum of £1,200.00, which was accepted by the Joint Liquidators'. The goodwill of the Company has been paid for in full.

### **Book debts**

The book debts had a book value of £22,000.00 and had an uncertain estimated to realise value in the Statement of Affairs. The Joint Liquidators pursued the debts with little success. One of the debtors entered into Administration, which resulted in no dividend being payable to unsecured creditors, and the second debtor provided sufficient evidence to show they had repaid their debt prior to the liquidation. On this basis, no realisations were made.

### Other Assets

An amount of £8,255.26 has been received, being the cash at bank at the date of liquidation.

During the Joint Liquidators investigations, it transpired that there was an overdrawn Directors Loan Account ('DLA'), which was owed by the director, Mr Andrew Garnham, in the sum of £3,919.00. Payment has been received in full.



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### 4. UNREALISED ASSETS

There were no unrealised assets, only those mentioned above.

### 5. INVESTIGATIONS

During the Review Period, the Joint Liquidators carried out an initial review of the Company's affairs in the period prior to appointment. This included seeking information and explanations from the director by means of a questionnaire; making enquiries of the Company's accountants; reviewing information received from creditors; and collecting and examining the Company's bank statements, accounts and other records.

The director provided the books and records of the Company. A completed director's questionnaire was not received despite the Joint Liquidators requests.

The information gleaned from this process enabled the Joint Liquidators to meet their statutory duties when submitting their confidential report on the conduct of the director to the Insolvency Service.

This work was carried out with the objective of making an initial assessment of whether there were any matters that may lead to any recoveries for the benefit of creditors. This would typically include any potential claims which may be brought against parties either connected to or who have past dealings with the Company.

This assessment revealed matters that the Joint Liquidators considered merited further investigation with the Company bank account statements highlighting transactions which required further clarification. The Joint Liquidators wrote to the director of the Company, Mr Andrew Garnham, and the Company's accountant requesting their comments in respect of the queried transactions, along with documentation to support same. A response was received from the accountant on 23 January 2016, which answered the queries raised.

The investigations department reconciled the overdrawn DLA, and it was discovered that the sum of £3,919.00 was owed to the Company. This has been repaid in fulf.

As no further matters for investigations have arisen, the Joint Liquidators have concluded their investigations.

### **6. CREDITORS' CLAIMS AND DIVIDEND PROSPECTS**

### Secured Creditors

The Company has not granted any charges over its assets.

### **Preferential Creditors**

There were no preferential creditors in the liquidation.

### **Unsecured Creditors**

No ordinary unsecured claims have been received to date. The director's Statement of Affairs estimated unsecured claims of £20,637.07.

### 7. JOINT LIQUIDATORS' REMUNERATION

A Statement of Affairs fee of £5,000.00 was approved at the initial meeting of creditors held on 25 March 2014 which has been drawn by us, as Joint Liquidators.

The Joint Liquidators' remuneration stated in the Receipts and Payments account is based on hourly costs at scale rates calculated on the time properly spent in the course of the liquidation and was approved at the initial meeting of creditors held on 25 March 2014.

In the current period the Joint Liquidators have incurred time costs of £1,130.00 representing 6.15 hours at an average hourly charge-out rate of £183.74. Total time spent to date on this assignment amounts to 102.89 hours at an average composite rate of £189.52 per hour resulting in total time costs to date of £19,499.75. Joint Liquidators' fees of £3,883.54 plus VAT have been drawn leaving outstanding time costs of £15,616.21, which will be written off.

Disbursements of £1,287.40 have been allocated to the case up to the anniversary of which £610.00 has been drawn leaving unbilled disbursements of £677.40 which will be written off.

- Silke and Co Ltd charge-out rates

All other payments have been made in accordance with the rules and regulations generally as to the payment of costs and expenses in the liquidation, details of which can be found below:

### Other Professional Costs

The sum of £3,096,56 was paid to Hays Specialist Recruitment in respect of petition costs.

As previously reported the Company was dissolved and reinstated on to the Company register. As a result of this, legal fees in the sum of £1,300.00 were paid to Foreman & Co Solicitors.

### 8. CREDITORS' RIGHTS

An unsecured creditor may, with the permission of the court or with the concurrence of 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question) request further details of the Joint Liquidator's remuneration and expenses, within 21 days of receipt of this report. Any secured creditor may request the same details in the same time limit.

An unsecured creditor may, with the permission of the court or with the concurrence of 10% in value of the creditors (including the creditor in question), apply to court to challenge the amount and/or basis of the Joint Liquidator's fees and the amount of any proposed expenses or expenses already incurred, within 8 weeks of receipt of this report. Any secured creditor may make a similar application to court within the same time limit.

### 10. CONCLUSION

There are no other outstanding matters and the affairs of the Company have been fully wound up.

Should any assets come to light following the closure of this case, Silke & Co Ltd reserve the right to offset any realisations against the unpaid time costs and disbursements.

### Rule 18.9

- (1) The following may make a written request to the office holder for further information about remuneration or expenses set out in a final report under rule 18.14:
  - A secured creditor;
  - An unsecured creditor with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors (including the creditor in question); or
  - Any unsecured creditor with the permission of the court.
- (2) A request or an application to the court for permission by such a person or persons must be made or filed with the court (as applicable) within 21 days of receipt of the report by the person, or by the last of them in the case of an application by more than one creditor.
