# Joint Liquidators' Report for the first year of the liquidation, 12 December 2014 to 11 December 2015

### 1 Introduction

We were appointed Joint Liquidator's on the 12 Decemebr 2014 by members and creditors of the company

The company's former registered office was Barclays Bank Chambers, High Street, Tenby, SA70 7HB and the company's registration number is 08269935

### 2 Realisation of Assets

### Stock

The Directors Statement of Affairs estimated the sum of £3,500 00 would be realised. The stock was sold by Gravel Auctioneers who had been instructed by the joint liquidators. The sum realised was £5,644 19

### **Bank Interest**

A sum of £1 00 has been received, gross of tax, for bank interest

A total amount of £6,229 71 has been realised to date. A receipts and payments account is attached to this report. VAT in the sum of £159 01 is still to be recovered.

### 3 Costs in the Liquidation

The Receipts and Payments account sets out the details of all payments made to the date of this report

An analysis of the Liquidator's costs and time spent to the date of this report is also attached

At the creditors meeting held on 12 December 2014 a resolution was passed that the Liquidator's be remunerated on a time cost basis according to the time properly spent by them and their staff in their duties in relation to the liquidation, this remuneration being drawn from time to time at the Liquidator's discretion

A copy of the Liquidators time and costs is attached to this report (SIP 9) which shows that to date £4.608 75 of time costs have been incurred
