Khidmat Home Care and Support CIC is created to address the need of homecare support for people in need for help or assistance. The activities of the CIC this year is to establish the systems and processes to operate as a provider to support individuals to require assistance care. We recognised the barriers facing people accessing care and spent this financial year evidencing and research on the needs and barriers accessing public services for Care. Partnership development was essential and working on care - we set about developing collaborative models of partnership with other third sector providers.

The appointment of a manager provided the capacity and skills to measure the level of care across inner city Birmingham especially within East Birmingham. Working with larger providers, we have supported the development of a collective of third sector providers working together delivering carer services.

This has increase access and reach of carers and establishing a good foundation to make positive impact of providing care services delivered directly or indirectly through other providers

There have been a number of consultations with three cohorts, residents, third sector and statutory agencies. We undertook consultation and events to identify the needs of people in care and their carers. We identified the barriers and collected evidence to determine the best approach to deliver services amongst ethnic minorities. The outcome from the consultation was to deliver collaborative activities with third sector.

There were two events engaging local residents to find out the need for care in the community. The findings was fed in the redesign of care through consultation with the Clinical Commissioning Group and the Local authority.

The outcome of the consultation led to the development of a carer's project led by a charity supporting those people who cared for people.
