ENQUIRES AND INVESTIGATIONS

I carried out a review of the Company's affairs in the period prior to appointment. This included seeking information and explanations from the director; making enquiries of the Company's accountants; reviewing information received from creditors; and collecting and examining the Company's bank statements, accounts and other records. The information gleaned from this process enabled me to meet my statutory duty to submit a confidential report on the conduct of the director to the Insolvency Service.

This work was also carried out with the objective of making an initial assessment of whether there were any matters that may lead to any recoveries for the benefit of creditors. This would typically include any potential claims which may be brought against parties either connected to or who have past dealings with the Company.

This assessment has been completed and I did not identify any further assets or actions which might lead to a recovery for creditors.

REALISATION OF ASSETS

Cash at Bank

The company's bank account has been closed and the closing balance of £477 has been received.

CREDITORS

Secured creditors

The Company has not granted any charges over its assets and has no secured creditors.

Preferential creditors

Employee claims

Six employees were made redundant as a result of the company's insolvency. Information and help has been given to employees to enable them to submit their claims online to the Redundancy Payments Service, who make statutory payments to employees on the company's behalf. The director's statement of affairs estimated preferential liabilities in relation to holiday pay to be £2,687.

The Redundancy Payments Service have made payments on the company's behalf and submitted a preferential claim of £3,909 in relation to wage arrears and holiday pay.

Unsecured creditors

The director's statement of affairs listed eleven unsecured creditors amounting to £61,991. To date claims have been received from five creditors totalling £52,780.

Dividend prospects

There is no prospect of a dividend to any class of creditor.

Prescribed Part

Where a floating charge is created after 15 September 2003 a prescribed part of the company's net property shall be made available to unsecured creditors.

The Company has not granted a floating charge to any creditor after 15 September 2003 and consequently there will be no prescribed part in this Liquidation.

FEES AND EXPENSES

Pre-Appointment Costs

A fixed fee of £3,000 plus VAT was agreed with the director, Mr C Newbold, prior to the liquidation, of which Mr Newbold has paid the sum of £2,083 plus VAT.

The Liquidator's fees

A decision procedure was convened for 10 December 2020 and held by correspondence. Creditors resolved that the remuneration of the liquidator be fixed on a time cost basis.

To date 16.4 hours have been spent in administering to the liquidation, incurring time costs of £4,100. Remuneration of £189.32 has been drawn.

Expenses

The Expenses that have been incurred and paid during the period are detailed below.

Statement of Insolvency Practice 9 ('SIP9'), requires that the office holder provide a statement of the office-holder's policy in relation to recharges of Expenses. SIP9 defines Expenses as either Category 1 or Category 2 Expenses.

Category 1 Expenses comprise specific expenditure directly referable to the case and a payment to an independent third party. Category 1 expenses can be paid without prior approval.
