UPON hearing Mr Aldis of counsel for the Applicants and the Respondents not attending or being represented

UPON considering the Applicants' application issued on 17 August 2018 to be removed and released as liquidators

**IT IS DECLARED:**

1. Pursuant to s.127(1) of the Act, that the transfers of 500 shares in the Company on 31 October 2016 from Ticket Globe Limited to each of the Respondents are not void.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

2. All proceedings in the winding up of County Developments (Northampton) Limited (“the Company”) be stayed altogether pursuant to section 147(1) of the Insolvency Act 1986 (“the Act”).
3. A copy of this order shall forthwith be forwarded by the Applicants to the registrar of companies, who shall enter it in his records relating to the company pursuant to section 147(3) of the Act.
4. The Applicants be removed as joint liquidators of the Company pursuant to section 172(2) of the Act.
5. The Applicants shall apply to the Secretary of State pursuant to rule 7.69 of the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 to be released as joint liquidators of the Company under section 174(4)(b) of the Act.
6. The Respondents as directors and shareholders of the Company, and their successors, be reinstated in control of the Company.
7. The costs of the application in excess of £3,000 be paid as an expense of the liquidation.
