NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2016

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

As at 31 March 2016 the company's liabilities exceeded its assets by £159,948. This was due to the amount owed to Mr A Murray and Mr S Game via their Directors' Loan accounts which showed balances due totalling £304,043 at 31 March 2016. Mr A Murray and Mr S Game have confirmed they will continue their support of the company for a period of at least 12 months from the date of signing the accounts to ensure it can continue to meet its liabilities as they fall due. As a result the Directors consider it it appropriate to prepare the accounts on a going concern basis.

Turnover

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents amounts invoiced during the year.

Fixed assets

All fixed assets are initially recorded at cost.

Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated so as to write off the cost of an asset, less its estimated residual value, over the useful economic life of that asset as follows:

Leasehold Property - Straight line over 21 years
Fixtures & Fittings - 20% reducing balance
Motor Vehicles - 25% reducing balance

Financial instruments

Financial liabilities and equity instruments are classified according to the substance of the contractual arrangements entered into. An equity instrument is any contract that evidences a residual interest in the assets of the entity after deducting all of its financial liabilities.

Where the contractual obligations of financial instruments (including share capital) are equivalent to a similar debt instrument, those financial instruments are classed as financial liabilities. Financial liabilities are presented as such in the balance sheet. Finance costs and gains or losses relating to financial liabilities are included in the profit and loss account. Finance costs are calculated so as to produce a constant rate of return on the outstanding liability.

Where the contractual terms of share capital do not have any terms meeting the definition of a financial liability then this is classed as an equity instrument. Dividends and distributions relating to equity instruments are debited direct to equity.
