Healthwatch Sandwell is the consumer voice for health and social care in Sandwell. Our work includes promoting consumer rights, addressing concerns, ensuring customer care mechanisms work, overseeing statutory consultations and linking with the community. We do this by promoting Healthwatch and our work, gathering information, and then researching and acting on issues raised. Our work during the year has included holding regular public meetings on health and social care issues, regularly contacting a network of over 40 community groups to hear what health and social care issues they are hearing, meeting with members of the community several times a week at public locations to gather their experiences and provide advice, developing the CompareDrs website to provide information on GP services, supporting, investigating and researching individual concerns about health and social care services raised by the public where there may be ongoing issues with providers, carrying out Enter and View visits to health and social care premises involving volunteers, and providing support and advice to the public via telephone, web, email, social media and face to face

Our main stakeholders are consumers of health and social care in Sandwell i.e. residents of Sandwell. Our Board is a community Board made up of local people. Our Board meetings and their meetings to consider health and social care issues are open to the public. We hold regular Health and Social Care Group meetings which are open and publicised to everyone in Sandwell. We have developed our Consultation Network with community and voluntary organisations who work with the communities of Sandwell, and provide a channel for the concerns they hear from their users. We have staff and volunteers who meet with the public continually at community locations to ask them about their experiences. We produce a quarterly report on the issues that we are hearing and the action that we have taken, which can include providing service users with advice and signposting, raising the issues with providers, carrying out further research and reporting to appropriate organisations, arranging meetings between providers and public, and developing and disseminating useful information.
