1 Introduction

- 1.1 I, Francesca Tackie of Mercury Corporate Recovery Solutions Ltd, Empress Business Centre, 380 Chester Road, Manchester, M16 9EA, was appointed as Liquidator of Absolute Building & Carpentry Limited (the Company) on 23rd May 2017. The affairs of the Company are now fully wound-up and this is my final account of the liquidation, which covers the period since my 23rd May 2017 to 7th June 2018 (the Period).

2 Receipts and Payments

2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period with a comparison to the directors' statement of affairs values, together with a cumulative account since my appointment at Appendix B, which provides details of the remuneration charged and expenses incurred and paid by the Liquidator.

3 Work undertaken by the Liquidator

3.1 This section of the report provides creditors with an overview of the work undertaken in the liquidation since 23rd May 2018 together with information on the overall outcome of the liquidation.

As stated in Section 2.13 of the first progress report there are no matters outstanding on the case.

Administration (including statutory compliance & reporting)

3.2 As you may be aware, the Liquidator must comply with certain statutory obligations under the Insolvency Act 1986 and other related legislation. Details about the work I anticipated undertaking in this regard was outlined previously. I have finalised my administration of the case with a view to its closure; which has included my preparing my final progress report.

Realisation of Assets

Insurance Claim

3.3 An investigation was undertaken in relation to the above. The outcome of my investigation was that a claim wouldn't be pursued due to no evidence being provided regarding forced entry into the Company's vehicle.

3.4 Director's Loan Account

Investigations were undertaken in relation to the above. The outcome from of my investigation was that no further action would be taken in relation to the loan account. This was because he is in debt personally and even if the position could be established to be overdrawn the prospect of a recovery would be unlikely due to his lack of assets.

Creditors (claims and distributions)

3.5 No work was conducted in relation to adjudicating creditors' claims as no dividend distribution was anticipated to be made. The reason for this is that no assets have been realised.

Investigations

- 3.6 Please see Sections 3.5 and 3.6 above regarding outcomes of investigatory work undertaken in this regard.
- 3.7 Some of the work I was required to undertake was to comply with legislation such as the Company Directors' Disqualification Act 1986 (CDDA 1986) and Statement of Insolvency Practice 2 Investigations by Office Holders in Administration and Insolvent Liquidations and may not necessarily bring any financial benefit to creditors, unless those investigations revealed potential asset recoveries that could have been pursued for the benefit of creditors.
- 3.8 My report on the conduct of the Directors of the Company to the Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy under the CDDA 1986 was submitted in accordance with statutory timescales and is confidential.
- 3.9 Since my last progress report I would advise that no further asset realisations have come to light that may be pursued by me for the benefit of creditors.

4 Outcome for Creditors

Unsecured Creditors

4.1 I received claims totalling £59,1116.67 from 7 creditors.

I can confirm that the realisations in the liquidation are insufficient to declare a dividend.

5 Liquidator's Remuneration & Expenses

The basis of the Liquidator's remuneration be a fixed fee of £7,500 plus VAT and 30% of any asset realisations.

- 5.1 I have not drawn any fees against the total set fee or percentage agreed above.
- 5.2 Attached as Appendix C is additional information in relation to the Liquidator's fees and the expenses and disbursements incurred in the liquidation.
