ORDER

UPON THE APPLICATION for a Block Transfer Order by Application Notice dated 26 June 2023.

AND UPON reading the evidence filed in support of the Application

AND UPON it appearing that Manjit Shokar (the “Outgoing Office-holder”) is no longer able to continue in office in respect of the cases referred to in the Application and annexed to this Order as Schedule A (the “Block Transfer Cases”)

AND UPON THE COURT being satisfied that it is expedient to transfer all the cases listed in Schedule A (Part 1) (annexed to this order) to the Second Respondent in one single order

AND UPON THE COURT being satisfied that it is expedient to transfer all the cases listed in Schedule A (Part 2) (annexed to this order) to the Third Respondent in one single order

IT IS ORDERED THAT:-

1. Permission is granted to amend the application notice to delete the second to fourth named applicants as applicants.
2. The Outgoing Office-holder be removed from office in respect of each of the Block Transfer Cases listed in Schedule A from the date of this order.
3. Steven Illes be appointed as the replacement office-holder in respect of each of the Block Transfer Cases listed in Part 1 of Schedule A from the date of this order.
4. Michael Colin John Sanders be appointed as the replacement office-holder in respect of each of the Block Transfer Cases listed in Part 2 of Schedule A from the date of this order.
5. The creditors in each of the Block Transfer Cases be notified of this order either by letter or by advertisement published in the London Gazette within 3 months of this order and the Applicant is required to advertise the transfer of the Block Transfer Cases in any event within 3 months.
6. Any creditor or, in the case of any members’ voluntary liquidation, any member, in respect of any of the companies listed in Schedule A who has an objection to this order shall have 56 days from the date of this letter or advertisement to apply to the Court to set aside or vary the terms of this order. The time period shall run from two business days after the letter is posted or from the date of advertisement, whichever is the later. Such application shall not affect the transfer of the Block Transfer Cases until further or other order by the Court.

7. The Replacement Office-holders appointed pursuant to paragraphs 3 to 4 of this order shall give notice of the terms of this order to the Secretary of State and the Registrar of Companies in respect of the liquidations and administrations listed in Schedule A and to any person who jointly holds office with the Outgoing Office-holder as soon as reasonably practicable.
8. Nothing in this order shall release the Outgoing Office-holder from any obligation to give and file notices in respect of his removal under this order in respect of the Block Transfer Cases.
9. Save in respect of an application under paragraph 6 of this order, the Outgoing Office-holder shall have his release as administrator subject to further order 56 days after the relevant notification pursuant to paragraph 7.
10. Save as provided in paragraph 9 of this order, the Outgoing Office-holder shall have his release upon application to the Secretary of State.
11. No Order as to costs.
12. Nothing contained in paragraph 11 shall prejudice the Applicant from charging to each of the Block Transfer Cases the cost of obtaining an insolvency practitioner's security bond in respect of those cases.
13. The Applicant shall ensure that a sealed copy of this Order is filed within the CE-file of each of the Block Transfer Cases before the High Court.
