TRUSTEES' REPORT

The trustees present their report and accounts for the year ended 31/12/2017

STRUCTURE GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Charity is constituted as a Company limited by guarantee, without a share capital, and is therefore governed by a Memorandum and Articles of Association. It is registered with Charity commission.

The Charity is organised so that the Members of the charity meet regularly to manage the affairs of the charity. The secretary is in charge of the day to day running of the charity.

The trustees, who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act, present their annual report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2018. The trustees have adopted the provisions of the Statement of Recommended Practise (SORP) in preparing the annual report and financial statements of the charity.

OBJECTS OF THE CHARITY PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES AND ORGANISATION OF OUR WORK

The charity's object and its principal activity continues to be the oversight and responsibility for the management of the church itself. Its major activity is to assist the Parish Priest in securing the preaching of the Holy Gospel, religious, educational and instructional activities and liturgical life all under the jurisdiction of the Parish.

The trustees consider that the performance of the charity this year has been satisfactory. The levels of donations for 2018 were well above the budgeted level.

The statement of Financial Activities shows a net inflow of £17,276 for the year.

The present level of funding is adequate and the trustees consider the financial position of the charity to be satisfactory.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1a. Incoming Resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

1b. Resources Expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

1c. Allocation And Apportionment Of Costs

All costs relate to the single activity of the charitable company and are recognised accordingly.

1d. Fund Accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Designated funds are funds set aside by the trustees out of unrestricted general funds for the specific future purposes or projects.

1e. Turnover

Turnover represents the invoiced value of goods and services supplied by the company, net of value added tax and trade discounts.

1f. Statement Of Cash Flows

The Company is exempt from including a statement of cash flows in its accounts, as it is a wholly owned subsidiary of, which is a company incorporated in the United Kingdom and has included a consolidated statement of cash flows in its consolidated accounts.
