Democracy Club worked with mySociety to create a website for crowdsourcing information on 2015 General Election candidates. Details of 4,000+ candidates were successfully crowdsourced, creating the most accurate and comprehensive database of general election candidate information ever made open to all

In the run-up to the election, we made this data available to anyone who could use it to inform voters. The most significant partnership was with Google, who built a search widget that would allow voters to search Google for a term like 'who can I vote for' and get instant answers. Commercial confidentiality prevents us from knowing the reach of this approach, but it is likely to have been in the millions of voters.

We used this data to run the <u>YourNextMP.com</u> website, which was visited by 1m+ users

The club also prototyped an online polling station finder tool
