In this financial year, Democracy Club created open data and services to help inform voters at elections across the UK. This included:

- mobilising volunteers to crowdsource data on 13,068 candidates for election in May 2016;
- serving 180,000 voters with information on those candidates;
- improving coverage of the polling station finder to over 47% of the electorate in Wales, where tens of thousands of people used it;
- for the first time, recording election results in an open way, live on election night;
- providing open data to the London School of Economics' project 'Democratic Dashboard', which served another 70,000 people;
- providing open data to Buzzfeed News who helped 7,000+ people to understand what elections were happening in their area.

Two of the directors spoke at and attended the annual nationwide meeting of electoral service teams and received positive feedback and suggestions for new ways of working that were acted upon.
