Turnover has been impacted in the financial year by COVID-19. The global pandemic affected

the economy as a whole, in particular the UK Lockdowns reduced the volumes of commercial

waste available as significant parts of UK industry closed. Volumes and revenue had recovered

to pre COVID-19 levels by the end of the financial year.

Alongside COVID-19 the business also suffered a total loss fire to the main process shed on

the 5/6th May, 2020. The Initial impact was to remove all waste processing capability resulting

in the business effectively closing for three months with no revenues but all the normal operating costs. This has reduced year

on year

revenues and associated profitability.
