#### Company activities and impact

Consultation and Design ServicesDuring this time we have: Worked with St Gemma's Hospice to continue developing and maintaining theiroutdoor spaces. Continued to work with Leeds Community Homes, consulting with the local community on designs for their site at Mistress Lane. Worked with The Great British Food Festival, delivering growing workshops. Continued working with Spring Bank Primary School to raise funds to co-create aclimate resilient garden for the pupils, staff and school community. Continued working with Meanwood Valley Partnership and a steering group of local stakeholders on the Love Meanwood Vision; to make Meanwood a climate resilient community where all neighbours can enjoy a healthy life with equal access to opportunities, facilities, services and public spaces. Including working with Yorkshire Wildlife Trust and Urban Wilderness to produce an initial water quality design report of the Meanwood Beck. Continued working with Forget Me Not Hospice at Russell House, hosting a volunteerplanting program and developing their peace garden. Social, Therapeutic HorticultureDuring this time we have: Delivered a staff wellbeing social, horticultural therapy program at St James' Hospital. With support from TCV & LOPF delivered a 12 week STH program aimed towardsolder people (Growing Older), helping them to begin socialising again after long periods of solation during the pandemic. Alongside Growing Older we also delivered a 12 week STH program, Growing WellWomen. Providing a safe and supportive space to encourage local women to reflect on and improve their wellbeing whilst beginning to socialise again.

Our stakeholders are the community groups for whom we design spaces and the people who ultimately use those spaces. Consulting them is a fundamental part of our approach to design work.
