The last year was tough on Museum in a Box. Every school and museum on the planet closed in 2020, and they're our main customer base. So, we decided to approach the challenge proactively, by lying "fallow". Our web shop remained open, and we provided some PDF materials for "museums at home" initiatives for all the new home educators created by lockdowns and the pandemic. Sadly, we had to let go of our office space, and our junior designer who had been with us for four years. Roll on to September, when we got one of our biggest orders to date from the Royal Mint Museum, who were seeking to celebrate the 50th birthday of the decimalisation of currency by sending a Museum in a Box to any care home across the UK who asked for one. That's ended up being one of our most successful deployments, with a flock of 45 boxes being sent to over 500 care homes in the last six months or so. The boxes are proving very useful and simple in reminiscence therapy, and the Royal Mint Museum has placed a follow up order for another 30 boxes!

We have been able to accumulate enough capital in reserve to afford our third batch of boxes, and were hoping to make them available before the end of the 2021 calendar year, but we have been affected by the global chip shortage, so will have to wait for that to settle. Over 50% of the batch is already spoken for, and our customers are patient re: delay.

We are in constant communication with our stakeholders, via email and our Slack group. It's been fantastic to watch and help Box deployments grow and develop. There are a few Boxes being used as part of a new theatre development in Walthamstow, in London, where local schoolchildren will interview older folks about their visits to the theatre in its previous incarnation, and we're looking forward to supporting that.

The Musical Museum in Brentford has installed Boxes in their gallery space so visitors can hear the sounds of the instruments too fragile to play.

We've been able to make several improvements to our web platform in the quieter phases too, which we've shared with all out stakeholders, who we basically classify as anyone with a Box.
