**PRIVATE COMPANY LIMITED BY SHARES
WRITTEN RESOLUTIONS
of
CHIP FINANCIAL LTD (“Company”)**

6th December 2023 (“Circulation Date”)

Pursuant to Chapter 2 of Part 13 of the Companies Act 2006 (“**CA 2006**”), the Board of Directors of the Company (“**Directors**”) propose that resolutions 1 and 3 below are passed as special resolutions and resolution 2 below is passed as an ordinary resolution (together “**Resolutions**”).

ORDINARY RESOLUTION

1) Authority to Allot

That, in accordance with section 551 of the CA 2006, the Directors be generally and unconditionally authorised to allot:

- a) A Ordinary Shares of £0.0000001 each in the capital of the Company up to an aggregate nominal amount of £0.125347;
- b) B Investment Shares of £0.0000001 each in the Company up to an aggregate nominal amount of £0.220402;
- c) B Voting Shares of £0.0000001 each in the capital of the Company up to an aggregate nominal amount of £0.162089

up to an aggregate nominal amount not exceeding the aggregate nominal amounts detailed in a), b) and c), each having the respective rights and subject to the respective restrictions set out in the Company’s articles of association provided that this authority shall, unless renewed, varied or revoked by the Company, expire 6 months after the date of this resolution save that the Company may, before such expiry, make an offer or agreement which would or might require Rights to be granted and/or shares to be allotted and the Directors may grant Rights and/or allot shares in pursuance of such offer or agreement notwithstanding that the authority conferred by this resolution has expired. This resolution shall become effective on the receipt of the relevant subscription monies and should any of the investors fail to advance their subscription monies, the relevant shares to which any such Rights shall relate shall not be allotted to that investor and the number of shares allotted shall be adjusted down accordingly or reallocated to an alternative investor on the same terms as that of the original. This authority is in addition to all subsisting authorities previously granted to the Directors.

SPECIAL RESOLUTION

2) Disapplication of Pre-Emption Rights

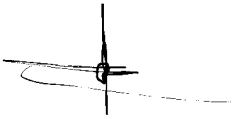
That, subject to the passing of resolution 1 and, if applicable, in accordance with section 570 of the CA 2006, the Directors be generally empowered to grant the Rights and subsequently allot equity securities (as defined in section 560 of the CA 2006) pursuant to the authority conferred by resolution 1, as if articles 4.2 and 4.3 of the Articles and (if applicable) section 561(1) of the CA 2006 did not apply to any such grant of Rights and subsequent allotment, provided that this power shall be limited to the respective nominal amounts and time period specified in resolution 1 (unless renewed, varied or revoked by the Company prior to or on that date), save that the Company may, before such expiry make an offer or agreement which would or might require Rights to be granted and/or equity securities to be allotted after such expiry and the Directors may grant Rights and/or allot equity securities in pursuance of any

such offer or agreement notwithstanding that the power conferred by this resolution has expired.

4. In the case of joint holders of shares, only the vote of the senior holder who votes will be counted by the Company. Seniority is determined by the order in which the names of the joint holders appear in the register of members.
