- (c) an agreement with any Competent Authority relating to other services;

2 Interpretation

- 2.1 The expressions 'Seller' and 'Buyer' include their respective successors in title.
- 2.2 Where any party comprises more than one person their obligations under this deed can be enforced against them all jointly or against each of them individually.
- 2.3 Any obligation of a party to do an act or thing includes an obligation to procure that it be done and any obligation not to do any act or thing includes an obligation not to permit or suffer that act or thing to be done by any person under its control.
- 2.4 Unless otherwise specified, a reference to legislation (including subordinate legislation) is to that legislation as extended, amended, modified, consolidated, or re-enacted from time to time and includes any instrument, order, regulation, permission, consent, licence, notice, direction, byelaw, statutory guidance or code of practice made or granted under such legislation.
- 2.5 Clause headings are for reference only and do not affect the construction of this deed.
- 2.6 Any reference to a clause, paragraph or schedule is to a clause, paragraph or schedule in this deed.

2.7 Where the words 'includes', 'including' or 'in particular' are used in this deed they are deemed to have the words 'without limitation' following them.

3 Charge

- 3.1 The Buyer with full title guarantee charges the Property by way of legal mortgage (subject only to the Prior Charge) as a continuing security for the payment or discharge of the Secured Amounts.
- 3.2 The priority to be given to the Prior Charge is as set out in the Deed of Priority.
- 3.3 The Seller must release from the Legal Charge (but conditional upon all (if any) due payment of the Planning Payment and payments of Overage having been paid):
 - 3.3.1 any part of the Property which is the subject of a Permitted Disposal;
 - 3.3.2 any part of the Property which ceases to be subject to the Overage Deed;
 - 3.3.3 any part of the Property which is still subject to the Legal Charge when the Overage Deed is determined and the Seller has no further claim against the Buyer.
- 3.4 Upon any Disposal of the Property or any part thereof which is not a Permitted Disposal and conditional upon:
 - 3.4.1 all (if any) due payments of the Planning Payment and Overage having been paid; and
 - 3.4.2 the Buyer complying with clause 6.1 of Schedule 1 of the Overage Deed; and
 - 3.4.3 the transferee or lessee complying with clause 6.1 of Schedule 1 of the Overage Deed;

the Seller will release:

- (a) that part of the Property which is the subject of the Disposal from this security; and
- (b) the Buyer from any liability under this Deed for any matter arising after the Disposal in respect of that part of the Property which is the subject of the Disposal;

(but without prejudice to the Buyer's continuing liability for prior breaches).

- 3.5 This Legal Charge shall remain in full force and effect as a continuing security unless and until the Seller discharges it and shall extend to cover the ultimate balance due from the Buyer to the Seller.
- 3.6 When the Buyer has paid all Secured Amounts the Seller will at the request and proper cost of the Buyer duly discharge this security.
- 3.7 The Buyer must pay all reasonable and proper professional and other costs, charges, fees and expenses incurred by the Seller arising out of the operation of this clause 3.

4 Buyer's covenants

4.1 Secured amounts

4.2 Permitted Disposals

4.3 Encumbrances

Not to create nor permit any encumbrance or further mortgage or charge upon the Property without the previous written consent of the Seller save that the Seller hereby consents to the Prior Charge (or any replacement thereof) and the Buyer will not require the prior consent of the Seller to enter into any funding arrangements / charges with a party who is substituting the Prior Charge for a new charge (which for the avoidance of doubt will rank in priority to this Legal Charge.

4.4 Rates etc

Punctually to pay and indemnify the Seller against all rents, rates, taxes, levies, assessments, impositions and outgoings whatsoever (whether governmental, municipal contractual or otherwise) which may be or may become imposed upon or payable in respect of the Property or any part of it.

4.5 Statutory requirements

To comply with all Statutory Requirements for the time being in force applicable to the Property.

4.6 Restrictive covenants

To observe and perform the restrictive and other covenants and stipulations (if any) affecting the Property.

5 Default

- 5.1 Section 103 of the 1925 Act does not apply to this Deed and the statutory powers of sale and appointing a receiver under ss 101 and 109 of the 1925 Act (as varied and extended under this Deed) will arise on the execution of this Deed.
- 5.2 The Secured Amounts will become immediately payable upon:
 - 5.2.1 the happening of an Event of Default; or

5.2.2 the holder of the Prior Charge taking any steps to enforce the Prior Charge or to demand money secured by it;

and at any time thereafter the Seller may in addition to any other remedies available to him:

- 5.2.3 exercise all the statutory powers conferred on mortgagees by the 1925 Act free from the restriction imposed by s 103 of the 1925 Act; and
- 5.2.4 appoint a Receiver (subject to the requirements of general law) to be receiver and manager of all or any part of the Property and for the Receiver to exercise the powers set out in clause 6.
- 5.3 If the Seller takes possession of the Property or causes a Receiver to be appointed in exercise of such statutory powers the Seller or such Receiver (in addition to his statutory powers) may eject from the Property the Buyer or any tenants of the Buyer or other persons at or in possession of the Property.
- If the Seller enforces the security constituted by this Deed at a time when no amount in respect of the Secured Amounts is due and payable, or when the Secured Amounts are not ascertained, the Seller (or the Receiver) may pay the proceeds of any recoveries effected by it into an interest-bearing account at a clearing bank. The Seller may (subject to the payment of any claims having priority to this security) withdraw amounts standing to the credit of such account for application as follows:
 - 5.4.1 paying all Costs incurred and payments made by the Seller (or the Receiver) in the course of such enforcement;

- 5.4.2 paying remuneration to the Receiver as and when the same becomes due and payable; and
- 5.4.3 paying the Secured Amounts as and when the same become due and payable.

6 Receiver

- 6.1 At any time after this security becomes enforceable, or at the request of the Buyer, the Seller may by writing, under hand, appoint any person or persons to be a Receiver of all or any part of the Property.
- 6.2 The Seller may at any time and from time to time in like manner remove any Receiver so appointed and appoint another in his place or appoint an additional person as Receiver.
- 6.3 The Seller may, either at the time of appointment or at any time subsequently and from time to time, fix the remuneration of any Receiver so appointed.
- None of the restrictions imposed by the 1925 Act in relation to the appointment of Receivers or as to the giving of notice or otherwise will apply.
- 6.5 Where more than one Receiver is appointed they will have the power to act severally.
- Any Receiver so appointed will be the agent of the Buyer for all purposes and the Buyer will be solely responsible for his acts or defaults and for his remuneration.
- 6.7 Any Receiver so appointed will have all the powers conferred on mortgagees or receivers by the 1925 Act (but without the restrictions contained in s 103 of that Act) except to the extent to which those powers are expressly or impliedly excluded by the terms of this Deed. In the event of ambiguity or conflict the terms of this Deed will prevail.
- 6.8 Any Receiver so appointed will have power, to such extent and upon such terms as he may in his absolute discretion think fit, to do or omit

to do anything which the Buyer could do or omit to do in relation to all or any part of the Property. In particular, (but without limitation) any such Receiver will have the power:

6.9

- 6.9.1 to take possession of, collect and get in all or any part of the Property and for that purpose to bring any proceedings in the name of the Buyer or otherwise;
- 6.9.2 to manage or carry on or concur in carrying on any business of the Buyer;
- 6.9.3 to raise or borrow money (whether from the Seller or otherwise) to rank for payment in priority to this security and with or without a charge on all or any part of the Property;
- 6.9.4 to sell (whether by public auction or private contract or otherwise), lease, vary, renew or surrender leases or accept surrenders of leases (without needing to observe the provisions of ss 99 and 100 of the 1925 Act) of, or otherwise dispose of or deal with all or any part of, the Property or of rights associated with all or any part of the Property or to concur in so doing whether in the name or on behalf of the Buyer or otherwise;
- 6.9.5 to seize and sever all or any fixtures at or in the Property other than and except trade machinery as defined by the <u>Bills of Sale Act 1878</u> and sell the same separately from the Property or its site:

- 6.9.6 to settle, arrange, compromise or submit to arbitration any accounts, claims, questions or disputes whatsoever which may arise in connection with any business of the Buyer or the Property or in any way relating to this security;
- 6.9.7 to bring, take, defend, compromise, submit to arbitration or discontinue any actions, suits or proceedings whatsoever whether civil or criminal in relation to the matters referred to in clause 6.9.6;
- 6.9.8 to disclaim, abandon or disregard all or any outstanding contracts of the Buyer and to allow time for payment of any debts either with or without security;
- 6.9.9 to repair, insure, manage, protect, improve, enlarge, develop, build, complete or reconstruct or replace all or any part of the Property and to apply for and obtain any appropriate permissions, approvals, consents or licences;
- 6.9.10 to acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise any further property assets or rights;
- 6.9.11 to appoint, employ and dismiss managers, officers, contractors and agents;
- 6.9.12 to elect to waive exemption under the <u>Value</u>

 Added Tax Act 1994 Schedule 10 paragraph

 2(1) on behalf of the Buyer in respect of the
 Property;

- 6.9.13 to do (whether in the name of the Buyer or otherwise) all such other acts and things as he may consider necessary or desirable for the protection, preservation, management, improvement or realisation of the Property or as he may consider incidental or conducive to any of the above matters or to the exercise of any of the above powers.
- 6.10 All money received by any Receiver must be applied by him:
 - 6.10.1 in payment of the costs, charges and expenses of and incidental to the appointment of the Receiver and the exercise of all or any of his powers and of all outgoings paid by him (including preferential debts);
 - 6.10.2 in payment to the Receiver of such remuneration as may be agreed between him and the Seller at, or at any time and from time to time after, his appointment;
 - 6.10.3 in or towards satisfaction of the Secured Amounts;
 and the surplus (if any) must be paid to the Buyer or other persons entitled to it.

7 Protection of third parties

No person dealing with the Seller or any Receiver appointed by him is to be concerned, bound or entitled to enquire or be affected by notice as to any of the following matters:

- 7.1 whether this security has become enforceable;
- 7.2 whether any power exercised or purported to be exercised under this Deed has arisen or become exercisable;

- 7.3 the propriety, regularity or purpose of the exercise or purported exercise of any such power;
- 7.4 whether any money remains due under the security; or
- 7.5 the necessity or expediency of the stipulations and conditions subject to which any disposition is made;

and the receipt of the Seller or any Receiver for any money will effectually discharge the person paying from such matters and from being concerned to see to the application or being answerable for the loss or misapplication of such money.

8 Prior charge

The Buyer covenants with the Seller duly and punctually to pay all sums payable in respect of the Prior Charge and from time to time to produce to the Seller within 5 Working Days of demand the receipts for every such payment.

9 VAT

All sums payable under this Deed are exclusive of VAT. Accordingly the Buyer will in addition pay any VAT chargeable or payable in respect of the Secured Amounts or otherwise pursuant to this Deed upon receipt of a valid VAT invoice.

10 Miscellaneous

- 10.1 Section 93 of the 1925 Act (restricting the right of consolidation) does not apply to this Deed.
- The Seller may at any time or times without discharging or diminishing or in any way prejudicing or affecting this security or any right or remedy of the Seller under this mortgage grant to the Buyer, or to any other person, time or indulgence, further credit, loans or advances or enter into any arrangement or variation of rights or, either in whole or in part, release, abstain from perfecting or enforcing or neglect or fail to perfect or enforce any remedies, securities, guarantees or rights which he may now or subsequently have from or against the Buyer or any other person.

10.3 Each of the provisions of this Deed is severable and distinct from the others and if at any time one or more of such provisions is or becomes invalid, illegal or unenforceable the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions will not be affected or impaired. This deed has today been executed by the parties.

11 Notice

- 11.1 A notice given under this Legal Charge shall be in writing and:
 - 11.1.1 shall be sent for the attention of the person, and to the address given at the beginning of this document (or such other address, fax number or person as the relevant party may notify to the other party); and
 - 11.1.2 shall be:
 - (a) delivered personally; or
 - (b) delivered by commercial courier; or
 - (c) sent by fax; or
 - (d) sent by pre-paid first-class post or recorded delivery
- 11.2 A notice is deemed to have been received:
 - 11.2.1 if delivered personally, at the time of delivery; or
 - if delivered by commercial courier, at the time of signature of the courier's receipt; or
 - 11.2.3 if sent by fax, at the time of transmission; or
 - 11.2.4 if sent by pre-paid first class post or recorded delivery, 48 hours from the date of posting; or
 - 11.2.5 if deemed receipt under the previous para graphs of this clause 11.2 is not within business hours (meaning 9.00 am to 5.30

pm Monday to Friday on a day that is a Working Day), when business next starts in the place of deemed receipt.

- To prove service, it is sufficient to prove that the notice was transmitted by fax to the fax number of the party or, in the case of post, that the notice was properly addressed and posted.
