#### IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the Applicants have leave to make a composite application in respect of the insolvency proceedings identified in the Schedules A to D attached to this application ("the Schedules").
- 2. That the proceedings listed in the Schedules, in so far as there are currently proceedings in any County Court or any District Registry in England and Wales other than the Birmingham District Registry, be transferred to the Birmingham District Registry solely for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, making the orders listed below.
- 3. 
