1 Statutory information

Children's Sensory Therapy Ltd is a private company, limited by shares, registered in England and Wales, registration number 10955440. The registered office is 20 Main Street, Aslockton, Nottinghamshire, NG13 9AL.

2 Compliance with accounting standards

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of FRS 102 Section 1A Small Entities. There were no material departures from that standard.

3 Accounting policies

The principal accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the financial statements are set out below and have remained unchanged from the previous year, and also have been consistently applied within the same accounts.

Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention as modified by the revaluation of certain fixed assets.

Presentation currency

The accounts are presented in £ sterling.

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible assets are included at cost less depreciation and impairment. Depreciation has been provided on a reducing balance basis at the following rates in order to write off the assets over their estimated useful lives:

Land & buildings 50 years
Fixtures & fittings 4 years
Computer equipment 4 years

Intangible fixed assets

Intangible fixed assets are included at cost less accumulated amortisation.

Goodwill is being amortised over 10 years

Pension costs

The company operates a defined contribution scheme for the benefit of its employees. Contributions payable are recognised in the profit and loss account when due.

Turnover

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, excluding discounts and rebates. Turnover from the rendering of services is recognised by reference to the stage of completion of the contract.
