We provide wrap around childcare for children between the ages of 0-11 years. Offering a breakfast club allows parents who need to get to work to know that their child is well cared for before school and that they have access to a varied and nutritious breakfast. Our full day care service offers children from birth to 5 years a home from home atmosphere with highly qualified staff. We charge by the hour which means we are one of the most affordable and flexible settings in the local area enabling more parents the opportunity to go out and find work.

Whilst offering these services we are also providing employment opportunities and opportunities for work experience placements to school and college students.
