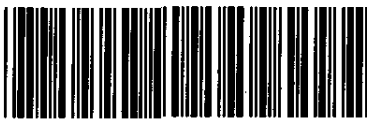

**ORDER**

**UPON** the Claimant's Claim by Part 8 Claim Form issued on 1 March 2023

**AND UPON** reading a letter from the First Defendant consenting to the Application

**AND UPON** reading the Witness Statement of Jane Waugh dated 28 February 2023, together with the exhibits, and the other documents marked in the Court file as having been read

**AND UPON** the Court being satisfied that the memorandum of satisfaction in full dated 20th December 2022 (the "MR04") in respect of the fixed and floating charge debenture executed on 28 November 2018 with the Companies House charge code 1110 8729 0001 (the "Debenture") is factually inaccurate and should be removed from the register

**AND UPON** the Court being satisfied that the MR04 and register contains a misstatement in marking the Debenture as "satisfied"

**AND UPON** the Court being satisfied that the aforesaid misstatement was accidental or due to inadvertence and it is just and equitable to grant relief to the Claimant

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. Upon delivery of a sealed copy of this Order to the Second Defendant the register be rectified by:
  - a) marking the Debenture as "outstanding" in the register of charges in relation to the First Defendant under s859M Companies Act 2006.
  - b) removing the memorandum of satisfaction filed on 20 December 2022 in respect of the Debenture from the register of the First Defendant under s1096 Companies Act 2006.
2. No Order as to costs.
3. Any party affected by this Order has a right to apply to have the Order set aside, varied, or stayed within seven days of the Order becoming known to them.
