During this financial year, Dansworks has been impacted by the Covid 19 global pandemic. The pandemic resulted in Dansworks being closed due to Lockdowns between April and August 2020 and from January to March 2021. Whilst closed during Lockdown, many members of the Dansworks team volunteered their time to keep families active and occupied online using Facebook and Zoom.

Dansworks did manage to open and operate under strict Covid guidelines from September to December 2020. Operating with the guidelines meant that class number were restricted, social distancing squares were introduced in studios, PPE was used by staff, no parents were allowed in the building, studio sanitizing took place after every class and no surplus items were brought into the studios. A professional risk assessment was done and updated regularly.

Dansworks hired additional venues during this period in order to provide additional safe space for extra classes due to the smaller class sizes. Further measures were put into place with the help of funding from sources including Arts Council England, Government Furlough Scheme, Grants from Tesco, Groundwork, Boost Lancashire, Rossendale Borough Council, Warburtons, Magic Little Grants and Local Giving (Postcode Lottery). The funding allowed for the following to be put in place.

- Rewiring to enable increased capacity for new air conditioning and equipment
- Air Conditioning
- Secure Door Entry (minimize numbers in the building)
- CCTV (enhanced security with no parents in the building)
- Alarm (Insurance standard for security of new equipment purchased)
- Virgin Broadband (Fastest available) with wired access points in studios
- Professional Zoom Subscriptions for Teachers (no time limits for online classes)
- New IT (Computers, cameras, sound equipment for professional online class delivery)
- LED Lighting (reducing carbon footprint)
- Changing cubicles, previously no changing facilities.
- Mental Health and Mindfulness Training for Teachers
- Mental Health Counselling for Staff and Students
- · Bespoke Website for online booking and related sales

This has benefitted local families by providing high quality equipment to support the high-quality teaching already in place in a much-improved environment, The facilities are now also used by other businesses too.

The work that we have done on mental health through this period has been of particular benefit to our staff, volunteers, students, and their families. The training undertaken by staff has transformed the way we approach and teach in our performing arts classes, dramatically improving communication and providing staff and student with the ability to recognize and deal with potentially stressful situations.
