The company runs a small community hub, café and heritage centre attached to St. Mary & all Saints Church in Droxford, Hampshire. The café commenced trading on 4th January 2020 but had to close in March 2020 due to Covid restrictions. The café is providing the following benefits to both residents and visitors to the village:

- A meeting point for the retired and home based carers that reduces the feeling of loneliness and isolation in the community
- A focus for parents with children at the local school and encourages intergenerational activities
- Facilities for local clubs and societies to meet, e.g. floral art club
- Refreshments and toilets for walkers and cyclists on both the South Downs Way and the Meon Valley Trail
- A focal point for historical information about the village and its inhabitants throughout the centuries
- Provision of fast broadband facilities to ensure universal access to internet based services and goods
- Wherever possible supporting and promoting local businesses, e.g. local artisan baker providing fresh bread and pastries and coffee from a local company roasting its' own beans.
- The provision of space to support local artists to display their artwork via exhibitions at 'Artist of the Month' displays

In addition the hub has a regular column in two local monthly magazines/newspapers and also sends out newsletters encouraging feedback on the services provided. When the café re-opens in May 2020 we will be holding a public AGM and will also be introducing a comments system for people who wish to give written feedback`
