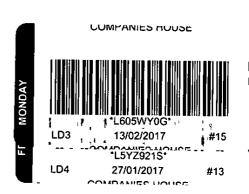

1. Accounting policies

11 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements of the McKinsey & Company, Inc United Kingdom (the "branch") have been prepared in accordance with United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), including adoption of Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland" ("FRS 102") and with Companies Act 2006, which have been applied consistently (see note 10)

The branch has taken advantage of the exemption available to wholly-owned subsidiaries from preparing a cash flow statement. The entity is not required legally or otherwise to present audited financial statements.

The financial statements are prepared on a going concern basis under the historical cost convention

1.2 Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and any impairment in value. Cost includes the original purchase price of the asset together with the costs attributable to bringing the asset to its working condition for its intended use.

Depreciation is provided on a straight-line basis over the useful life. The useful life and depreciation method are reviewed periodically to ensure that the method and period of depreciation are consistent with the expected pattern of economic benefits from items of property, plant and equipment. The estimated useful life of property, plant and equipment are assessed as

13 Current tax

Taxation is based on the profits and income for the period as determined in accordance with the relevant tax legislation, together with adjustments to provisions for prior periods. Tax payable is calculated using tax rates that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the Statement of Financial Position date.

Current taxation is recognized in the Statement of Comprehensive Income for the period, except to the extent that it is attributable to a gain or loss recognised outside the Statement of Comprehensive Income, in which case the current tax is recognised in the statement of total recognized gains and losses, or equity, as applicable

14 Deferred tax

Deferred tax is recognized on timing differences arising between the recognition of gains and losses in the financial statements and their recognition in a tax computation. The tax rates used are the rates that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the Statement of Financial Position date.

Full provision is made for deferred tax liabilities. Deferred tax assets are recognized to the extent that they are more likely than not to be regarded as recoverable against suitable taxable profits. Deferred tax is recognized in the Statement of Comprehensive Income for the period, except to the extent that it is attributable to a gain or loss recognised outside the Statement of Comprehensive Income, in which case the deferred tax is recognised in the statement of total recognized gains and losses, or equity, as applicable. The deferred tax balances are not discounted.

1. Accounting policies (continued)

1.5 Accrued income

Accrued income values contracts in progress at the year-end including the relevant profit element. Any amounts received on account from clients for which services have not been rendered are included in creditors in accordance with the revenue recognition policy.

1.6 Pension

McKinsey UK operates a defined contribution pension scheme for its employees. The amount charged to the Statement of Comprehensive Income represents the amount paid/payable for the year.

1.7 Turnover

Turnover is recognized as services are rendered. The impact of revisions to engagement revenues are recognized in the period in which those changes become known

If at the Statement of financial position date the completion of contractual obligations is dependent on external factors (and thus outside the control of the entity), then revenue is typically recognized when the contingent event occurs. However, in certain cases where similar work types are involved on a more regular basis, the contingent event is considered probable and there is historic evidence of these being settled, revenue is recognized as contract activity progresses.

18 Foreign currencies

Pounds Sterling is the functional currency for the branch. All assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currency are translated at year end exchange rates other than fixed assets that are denominated at the applicable historical rates. Revenue and expenses are translated at current monthly exchange rates except for depreciation/amortisation of fixed assets that are recorded at historical rates.

19 Leases

Rentals payable under operating leases are charged against income on a straigh line basis over the lease term

1.10 Trade receivables

Short term trade recievables are measured at transaction price, less any impairment

1.11 Trade payables

Short term trade payables are measured at transaction price. Other financial liabilities are measured initially at fair value, net of transaction costs, and are measured subsequently at amortised cost using the effective interest method.

8. Employee Stock Option Plan

McKinsey and Company, Inc (the Firm) which is the parent company of the branch provides a share based payment plan (the Plan), to the eligible employees of the branch. Options awards are generally granted with an exercise price equal to the book value of the Firm's common stock at the date of grant. Options can be exercised after the third anniversary of the grant and expire in 30 days if not exercised.

The expenses related to these options is reflected as a component of personnel costs in the statement of comprehensive income. The related expense is measured as the difference between the exercise price and the book value per share as of the exercise date. The expense recognised in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2015 is £864,115 (2014 £692,243)

The total income tax benefit related to the options granted recognised in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2015 was £174,983 (2014 £148,832)

Key Management Personnel

The key management personnel in relation to the branch includes individuals who are not remunerated or employed by this entity. The aggregate remuneration of those who we consider comprise key management personnel that is paid by this entity is £86,998,228 (2014 - £72,614,704). Note though that the key management personnel receive further remuneration from other Group entities, so the figure paid by this entity is not the aggregate remuneration received by these individuals from the Group.

10. Transition to FRS102

This is the first year that the branch has presented its results using the new UK GAAP reporting standard FRS 102 ("FRS 102") The effective date of transition of FRS 102 is January 1, 2014

The layout and names of the primary statements have changed on transition to FRS 102. The balance sheet has become "Statement of Financial Position", profit and loss account has been renamed to "Statement of Comprehensive Income". A Statement of Changes in Equity is now presented.

In preparing its opening balance sheet, the branch has adjusted the amounts reported in previous financial statements for the years 2013 and 2014. On transition, the profit for the year 2013 and 2014 has been increased by £1,728,780 and £534,764 respectively. This has resulted in the profit and loss reserve account increasing as follows.

- 1 January 2014 from £6,792,751 as reported in the prior year to £8,521,517 as reported in the Statement of Changes in Equity
- 1 January 2015 from £11,906,712 as reported in the prior year to £14,170,242 as reported in the Statement of Changes in Equity
- 1) Turnover As an impact of transition, in case of revenue contracts where consideration is based on a contingent event that is outside the control of the branch and if there is historic evidence of these being settled, the revenue is recognized as contract activity progresses
- 11) Pension As an impact of transition, gain / (loss) of re-measurement of the net defined benefit liability is now recognised in the financial statements and recorded in Profit and loss account under Statement of Changes in Equity
